Owner Experience Review

Owners commonly use the Gamefish 25 from SEA HUNT for family day trips and both inshore and offshore fishing, frequently trailering the boat between regions. Reported model years are roughly in the 2013–2020 range. On the

water many owners praise a soft, dry ride that remains composed in 2–3 ft chop, and some have reported runs as far as about 22 miles offshore. Typical twin F150 powerplants are commonly seen, with owners noting a cruising speed near ~30 mph and a top end around 44 mph.

Fishing functionality is a highlight: owners point to a 360° fishable cockpit, several insulated fishboxes, and a leaning-post livewell, while bow cushions and a removable transom seat retain family comfort; certain builds include a small head. Practical downsides reported include difficult bilge access—described by several owners as “terrible”—and a trim/trim-tab behavior that in some boats requires the tabs down to stop bouncing when trimming underway. There are also cosmetic and fit-and-finish complaints (cushion logos peeling after three years, notes about unfinished fiberglass, exposed wiring or plastic components, and questions about gelcoat longevity). Service-wise, routine items called out include the freshwater pump located in the bilge and batteries placed in the lower aft console area, both of which can complicate access for maintenance.

Pros and Cons

- Soft, dry ride; owners report comfort in 2–3 ft chop.
- True 360° fishable cockpit with multiple livewells and large insulated fishboxes.
- Versatile for family use with bow cushions, a removable transom seat, and trailer-friendly handling.
- Bilge access is difficult for routine maintenance.
- Sensitive trim behavior underway may require tabs down to prevent bouncing.
- Reports of fit-and-finish and cosmetic durability issues, including cushion logos peeling and concerns about wiring and gelcoat.
