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## OVERVIEW

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The 322 Offshore from SEA PRO is a purpose-built motor yacht centered on a center console layout. It is driven by twin Suzuki outboards using gas and features a fiberglass deck. Measuring 32 ft (9.75 m) LOA with a 10 ft (3.33 m) beam, the model appeals to owners who want uncomplicated operation paired with solid on-water performance. ## Owner Experience Review

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Owners and demo skippers describe the 322 Offshore by SEA PRO as a bona fide offshore platform that also serves well as a family day boat. On the water, the 24.5° deep V entry, 10'4" beam and foam filled hull sides deliver a composed, predictable motion in heavier seas, and reports frequently highlight that joystick control plus power steering simplify tight space handling. Manufacturer and dealer figures place cruise speed at roughly ~36.7 mph with a top end near ~59.4 mph; a 207 gallon fuel capacity paired with an advertised ~284 mile range supports extended coastal or offshore runs.

The model's fishing and comfort appointments are practical: a roomy cockpit with bow seating that includes flip up backs, a stern bench seat and a capacious center console with a single enclosed pump out head accommodate family outings, while the leaning post bait station with sink, twin 30 gallon pressurized livewells and in floor macerated fish boxes suit offshore anglers. At the helm, dealers point to large Simrad multifunction displays, deluxe helm seating with electric slide adjustments, and optional hardtop and digital switching packages. Serviceability features include foam filled hull sides and a vinyl ester barrier coat intended to reduce osmosis; several dealer listings cite a 10 year hull warranty, though buyers should confirm the precise terms in writing. Because the model debuted around 2024, long term reliability data is still sparse, and most publicly available impressions come from dealer demos and new boat sales listings.

## Pros and Cons

- Confident behavior in rough water thanks to the 24.5° deep V, 10'4" beam and foam filled hull sides.
- Ready to fish offshore layout with dual 30 gal pressurized livewells, in floor macerated fish boxes and plentiful storage.
- Solid performance and range figures: about ~36.7 mph cruise, ~59.4 mph top speed and an advertised ~284 mile range on 207 gallons.
- Limited long term owner feedback at present, since the model is a recent (c.2024) introduction.
- Optional premium helm and hardtop features mean equipment levels can vary between boats.
- Warranty coverage details differ by dealer; verify the advertised 10 year hull warranty in writing.
