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# OVERVIEW

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The 240 Sundeck by SEA RAY is a flexible motorboat in the runabout category, built on a resilient fiberglass and plastic hull and powered by a single Suzuki outboard. Offered through Shestakov Yacht Sales with broker Andrey Shestakov, it serves buyers after capable, straightforward dayboating in a 24 ft (7.32 m) package.

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## Selecting a 240 Sundeck

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Opting for the 240 Sundeck makes sense when you prioritize easy handling, a single-engine layout, and time-tested construction materials. As a motor yacht laid out as a runabout, it provides an open, social cockpit while remaining nimble and compact. At 24 ft (7.32 m) LOA it stays manageable for trailering or close-quarters maneuvering, yet retains the finish and styling expected from SEA RAY.

## Owner Experience Review

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Owners commonly describe the 240 Sundeck from SEA RAY as a highly adaptable family bowrider and dayboat whose popularity began with its 1995 introduction and continued into the 2000s and 2010s. Typical usage includes lake runs and light coastal outings with children and friends, followed by anchoring for a midday swim — the ample cockpit, sunpads, and swim platform make that routine effortless. One owner summed it up as “probably the best all-around, trailerable sport boat” SEA RAY produced, reflecting frequent praise for its simplicity and weekend-friendly layout.

On the water, owners report lively acceleration and comfortable cruise behavior when equipped with MerCruiser sterndrive power. It rides reasonably well in chop if the pilot keeps the bow raised and uses measured throttle inputs, but compared with heavier hulls it can feel livelier in rough conditions and some owners note a tendency to roll at anchor; many find trim tabs and refined helm technique solve those quirks rather than any single mechanical defect. The sociable deck plan receives steady acclaim, though the small cuddy cabin is best suited to short overnight stays rather than extended cruising.

Long-term owners note maintenance realities tied to age and I/O drivetrains: upholstery and carpeting commonly need renewal, and recurring service items include trim tab leaks, outdrive/drive seal issues, oil accumulating in the bilge, and intermittent cooling or hose faults. On certain MerCruiser MPI setups, reports include vapor lock, trim sender failures, and occasional water flow warnings. With engines mounted beneath the aft deck, routine

servicing can be confined and awkward, and overall condition tends to mirror how diligently prior owners maintained the boat.

## Pros and Cons

- Versatile family dayboat well suited to lakes, light coastal cruising, and straightforward weekend anchoring.
- Quick to plane with brisk acceleration relative to its class.
- Social cockpit arrangement, rear-facing sun pad, and swim platform ideal for lounging and waterside activity.
- Can feel more lively in chop or at rest, making judicious use of trim tabs and throttle necessary.
- Cuddy cabin is compact and best for brief overnights rather than extended liveaboard use.
- Pre-owned examples commonly need upholstery refresh and attention to I/O components such as trim tabs, drive seals, and cooling hoses.

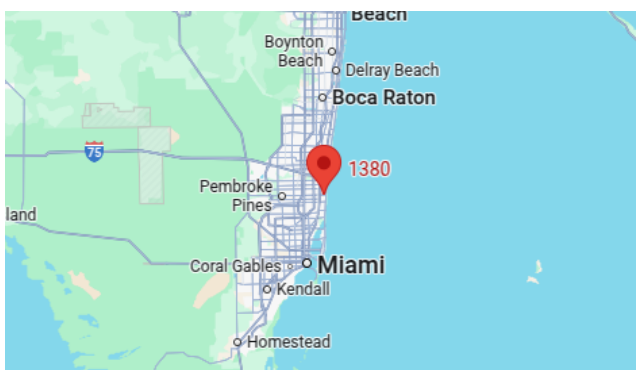
