OVERVIEW

The 450 Express Bridge from SEA RAY blends the functional layout of an express with the elevated sightlines of a bridgedeck. As a motor yacht built on a Deep Vee running surface with a robust fiberglass hull, it strikes a balance between onboard comfort and capable handling. Shestakov Yacht Sales, led by broker Andrey Shestakov, stands ready to assist with selection, inspections, and purchase logistics.

Selecting a 450 Express Bridge

Deciding on the 450 Express Bridge means matching its established specification set to how you intend to cruise. If your priorities include twin Cummins inboard diesels, a Deep Vee hull form for predictable motion, substantial tankage, and practical guest accommodations, the 450 Express Bridge should be on your shortlist. The team at Shestakov Yacht Sales and broker Andrey Shestakov will support condition assessments, market comparisons, and scheduling of viewings and professional surveys.

Q: What type of yacht is the 450 Express Bridge? A: It is a motor yacht produced by SEA RAY featuring a fiberglass/plastic build and a **Deep Vee** hull layout.

Q: What **engines** power this model? A: This model is fitted with **2 Cummins inboard diesel** engines, chosen for their durability and service network.

Q: How many **accommodations** and **heads** are on board? A: The interior sleeps **up to 6** and includes **2 heads** , making it well suited for family outings or hosting guests.

Q: What is the **draft** and **beam** ? A: Maximum draft is **11.209 ft (3.4166 m)** , and beam measures **14 ft (4.47 m)** , contributing to interior roominess and onboard stability.

Owner Experience Review

Owners are drawn to the 450 Express Bridge from SEA RAY for its family-friendly practicality and its social, day-boat versatility. The three-stateroom, two-head, galley-up plan offers a raised dinette, an airy salon, and approximately 6'2" of headroom, while the expansive cockpit and molded boarding steps lead naturally to a spacious flybridge equipped with a wet bar and wraparound seating. Many owners also specify a transom live-well and a large fish box, so the cockpit that's perfect for entertaining can also serve as a capable fishing platform. One owner summed up their feelings plainly: "Great boat we love it as well!"

On the water, owners and brokers commonly report an efficient cruise range between 18–22 knots with top-end speeds into the mid 20s, dependent on engine tune and prop selection. Reviews often describe the boat as "poised, trustworthy" and "nimble, responsive" in ordinary chop, though it is not intended as a heavy-weather offshore passagemaker. Forum discussions note that pod/Zeus-driven sedan variants tend to feel sportier and quicker, whereas the V-drive Cummins-powered 450 Express Bridge delivers a steadier, more relaxed ride. Routine ownership is focused on typical diesel and genset maintenance, and some owners have reported stringer/core issues on a subset of boats; the positive is that engine-room access is generally good via a large hatch beneath the cockpit stairs, but a comprehensive survey is advised.

Pros and Cons

- Liveable three stateroom, two head galley up arrangement with a raised dinette and about 6'2" headroom makes it well-suited to family cruising.
- Generous cockpit and roomy flybridge with molded stairs, wet bar, and wraparound seating simplify entertaining; many boats are also fitted with a live well and sizable fish box for fishing outings.

- Comfortable cruise speeds in the 18–22 knot range with poised, nimble handling in typical chop.
- Not designed for heavy weather offshore passages, so voyage planning is important.
- Documented owner reports of stringer/core concerns on some boats mean a detailed survey is essential.
- The V drive diesel 450 Express Bridge offers a steadier, more relaxed feel compared with some pod/Zeus driven sedan variants that feel sportier and faster.

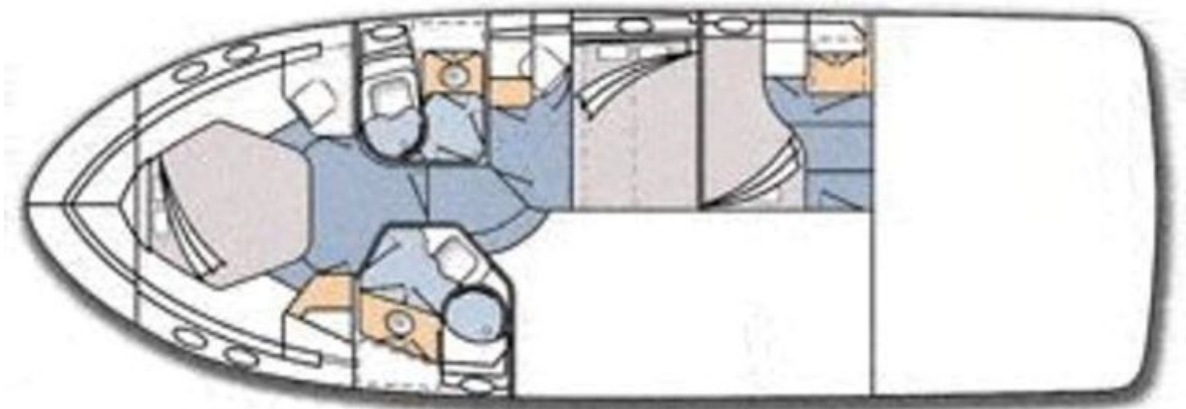
