OVERVIEW

The 580 Sundancer from SEA RAY is a polished motor yacht engineered for comfortable, efficient cruising aboard a sturdy fiberglass and plastic platform featuring a Semi-Displacement hull. Measuring 60 ft overall with a 15 ft beam and driven by twin MAN inboard diesels, it maintains a 26-knot cruise and can reach 30 knots. - Performance: Designed to cruise at 26 knots with a 30-knot top end (equivalent speeds in mph listed below) to keep passages timely.
- Construction: fiberglass and plastic hull with a Semi-Displacement running surface; decks constructed of Fiberglass.
- Layout essentials: Two heads to accommodate owner and guest comfort during extended stays.
- Capacities for extended outings: Substantial tanks with 825 gallons of fuel

Q: What type of yacht is the 580 Sundancer? A: It's a motor yacht laid out as a versatile cruiser built on a fiberglass and plastic hull by SEA RAY.

Q: What are the key performance numbers? A: The vessel's **cruise speed** is 26 kn (29.92 mph) and its **maximum speed** is 30 kn (34.52 mph) courtesy of the Semi-Displacement hull form.

Q: What engines power the boat? A: Propulsion is supplied by **2 x MAN inboard diesel** engines, chosen for durability and accessible maintenance.

Q: What are the principal dimensions and capacities? A: **LOA** 60 ft (18.29 m), **beam** 15 ft (4.85 m), **draft** 14.764 ft (4.5 m); **fuel** 825 gal, **water** 200 gal; and the layout includes **2 heads** for onboard convenience.

Owner Experience Review

Owners select the 580 Sundancer by SEA RAY for family-focused and coastal cruising where 2–3 stateroom arrangements and sizeable fuel and water tanks are beneficial. It performs well as a weekend social platform, featuring a bridgedeck designed for entertaining with flexible track mounted seating, an onboard wet bar, teak accents, and a hydraulic swim platform that sees frequent use. Many hulls remain in private hands rather than being chartered; brokers often note single owner provenance, owner-led upgrades, and comprehensive service histories.

Underway, the modified deep V (approximately 17° at the transom) is tuned to

deliver a comfortable ride when paired with appropriate power and trim. Reports note around 25-knot cruising with MAN 900s, and 25–30 knots with MAN 1100s, with top ends exceeding 30 knots; the yacht tracks steadily, leans cleanly through turns, and gives a feel similar to a larger vessel. Piloting qualities—sightlines beneath the hardtop and helm layout—receive consistent approval. Belowdecks, owners praise the high gloss cherry joinery, Corian countertops, maple flooring, and Ultra leather seating, along with a full beam amidships master and a roomy forward guest cabin offering generous headroom. Like any substantial yacht, maintenance is a material consideration: reverse cycle A/C systems, an Onan generator, and a watermaker feature in ongoing service schedules; MAN diesels have prescribed service points (notably the 1,000 hour interval), and owners commonly report recurring items such as exhaust bellows and trim sender replacements. Older SEA RAY hulls require diligence to prevent stringer/core deterioration if they have been neglected or stored in wet conditions.

Pros and Cons

- Spacious, well appointed interior featuring a full beam master, ample headroom, and premium finishes.
- Superb entertaining capabilities with an enclosed hardtop, dual sunroofs, adaptable bridgedeck seating, wet bar, and hydraulic swim platform.
- Confident handling and ergonomic helm layout; the modified deep V offers steady tracking, clean banking, and a presence that feels larger than its length.
- Significant systems and MAN diesel service milestones (for example, the 1,000 hour interval) contribute to elevated ongoing maintenance costs.
- The hull rewards healthy installed power and attentive trim adjustments to achieve its top performance and best ride qualities.
- Owners note recurring service items like exhaust bellows and trim senders, and older examples from SEA RAY can present stringer/core issues if

maintenance or storage has been inadequate.

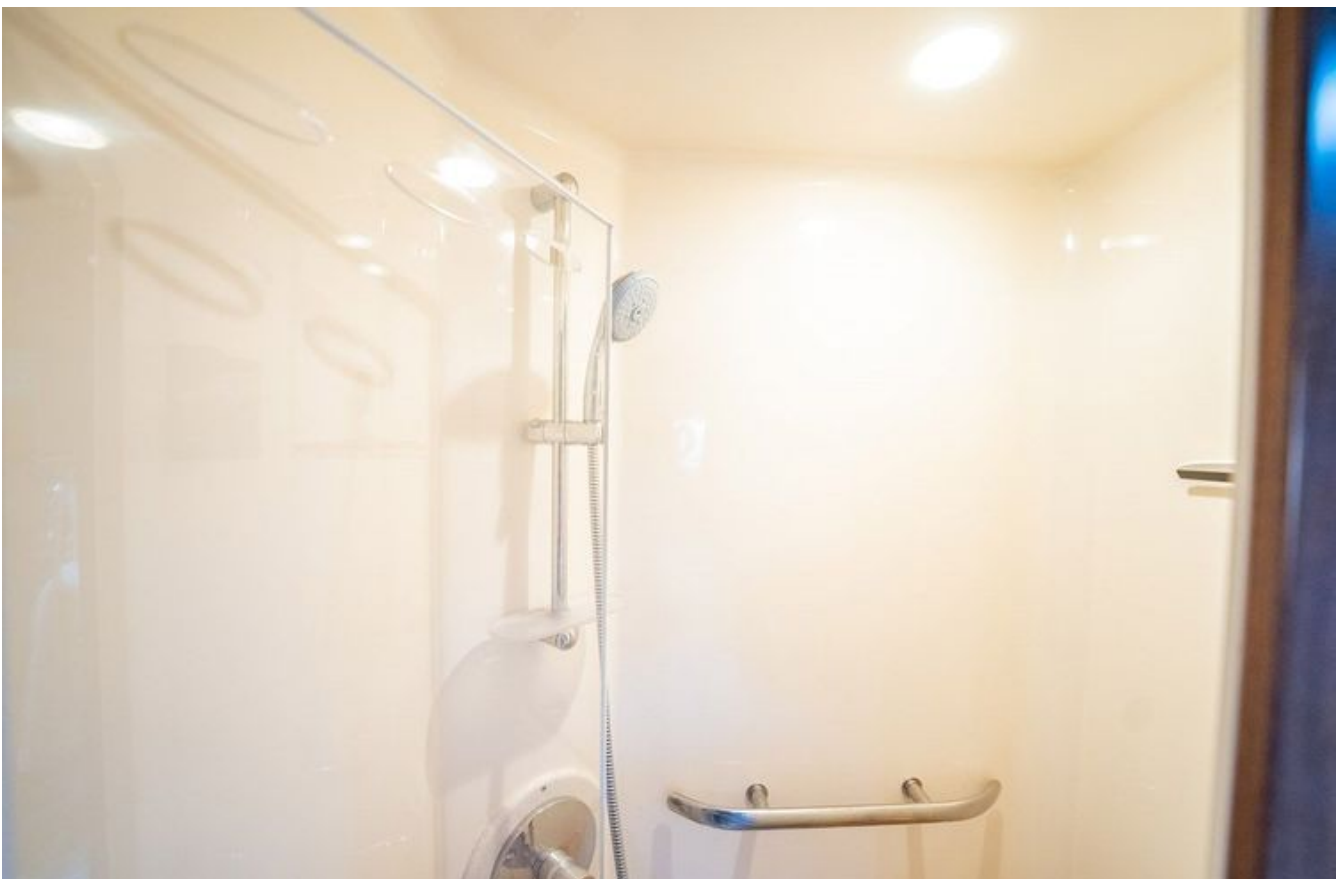
