OVERVIEW

The ISLANDER from SEAFORTH is a 36 ft (10.97 m) trawler-class motor yacht constructed with a fiberglass and plastic hull. The model is marketed by Andrey Shestakov and Shestakov Yacht Sales.

Selecting a ISLANDER

If your priority is relaxed, fuel-efficient cruising powered by a single inboard diesel and uncomplicated systems, the ISLANDER presents a sensible option. Designed to cruise comfortably at 8 kn with a top end near 10 kn, it provides accommodations for up to 4 people (sleeps 3) and includes one head, making it well suited to couples or small families who value easy, comfortable passages. With a draft in the 3.0–3.5 m range, it is intended for deeper berths and confident offshore tracking.

Features of the Model

- A functional trawler arrangement within the broader motor yacht category.
- Durable fiberglass and plastic hull paired with a fiberglass deck.
- Powered by a single Volvo inboard diesel for straightforward, dependable propulsion.
- Practical tankage: 300 gal fuel capacity and 150 gal freshwater capacity.
- Hull form and interior layouts developed by Seaforth for purposeful functionality.
- A comfortable 12 ft (3.66 m) beam that supports liveaboard-friendly living spaces.

Questions and Answers

Q: What type of yacht is the ISLANDER? A: The **type** is a trawler within the motor yacht class, built with a fiberglass and plastic hull by SEAFORTH.

Q: What are the **cruising speed** and **maximum speed** ? A: The **cruising speed** is 8 kn (9.21 mph) while the **maximum speed** is 10 kn (11.51 mph).

Q: What is the **draft** of the yacht? A: The **draft** is specified between 9.843 ft

(3.0 m) and 11.483 ft (3.5 m).

Q: How many **accommodations** and **sleeps** does it have? A: The boat offers **accommodation** for 4 people, **sleeps** 3, and includes 1 head.

Q: What **engine** powers the yacht and what are the **fuel** and **water** capacities? A: It is powered by 1 x Volvo **inboard diesel** ; **fuel capacity** is 300 gal and **water capacity** is 150 gal.

Owner Experience Review

Presented as a leisure trawler/pilothouse, the ISLANDER from SEAFORTH is well suited to coastal passages, island runs, and Delta-style cruising while hosting family and guests. On the water it behaves much like a slow-displacement trawler: brokerage listings identify a comfortable cruising pace near 8 knots and a top speed around 10 knots, with the single inboard Volvo diesel (some listings note a KAMD300) providing consistent, low-speed maneuverability and a steady, conservative ride that matches its Downeast picnic-boat silhouette.

Life aboard emphasizes sensible comfort for weekend trips and day outings. The salon provides about seven feet of headroom, a full galley, a dinette, a generous V-berth, and an enclosed head with shower; published accommodation counts show sleeps three with a single head. The aft cockpit features a wide bench and a U-shaped lounge surrounding a table, while the helm area includes two leather swivel seats and good sightlines; teak decking in the cockpit and on the swim platform, a fully enclosable cockpit canvas, and a Maxwell windlass complete the cruising equipment. Routine upkeep follows standard Volvo diesel maintenance schedules, and because owner-forum discussion specific to this model is limited, many buyers depend on broker records. For example, a 2005 listing noted a non-operational Espar diesel heater and an air-conditioner issue on that particular boat, highlighting the

importance of checking climate systems during survey.

Pros and Cons

- The single inboard Volvo diesel offers steady, low-speed displacement handling ideal for relaxed coastal trawler cruising.
- Interior comfort is strong, with roughly seven feet of headroom, a full galley and dinette, a large V-berth, and an enclosed head with shower.
- The cockpit and helm are arranged for entertaining, featuring a U-shaped lounge, a wide aft bench, two leather helm seats, and clear sightlines, plus enclosable canvas and teak trim.
- Performance is modest, with most listings indicating an ~8-knot cruise and a top speed around 10 knots.
- Sleeping capacity is limited to three in the listed layout with one head, making it better suited to short breaks and small groups than long-term liveaboard cruising.
- There is limited public owner-maintenance discussion specific to this model, so some long-term idiosyncrasies are less well documented.
