- Powerplant and economy: twin inboard Cummins diesel [[spec engines]] delivering a cruising speed of 9 kn (10.36 mph) and a top speed near 11.5 kn (13.23 mph)
- Capacities sized for extended cruising: fuel capacity 1100 gal and freshwater capacity 400 gal
- Accommodation layout: berths for up to 7 guests and 2 heads for flexible family or guest arrangements

- Solid construction: dependable fiberglass build hull paired with a fiberglass deck

Questions and Answers

Q: What is the yacht's **type** ? A: The 53 Ocean Trawler is a motor trawler conceived in the traditional trawler style and constructed on a fiberglass platform.

Q: What are the **performance** figures and **engines** ? A: Propulsion comes from two inboard Cummins diesel engines. Typical cruise speed is **9 kn (10.36 mph)** , with a reported top speed around **11.5 kn (13.23 mph)** .

Q: How many guests can the yacht **accommodate** and how many **heads** are onboard? A: The layout sleeps **up to 7** guests and includes **2 heads** , providing practical flexibility for family cruising or guest arrangements.

Q: What are the onboard **capacities** for **fuel** and **fresh water** ? A: The yacht carries **1100 gal** of fuel and **400 gal** of fresh water—capacities that support extended periods aboard the 53 Ocean Trawler.

Q: What are the **materials** used for the **hull** and **deck** ? A: The hull is built of fiberglass and the deck is **Fiberglass** , both constructed by SELENE YACHTS. For detailed material information and inspections, consult Andrey Shestakov at Shestakov Yacht Sales.

Owner Experience Review

Owners commonly choose the 53 Ocean Trawler from SELENE YACHTS for serious passagemaking and family liveaboard use. With owner reported and published ranges exceeding 2,000 nautical miles at an economical pace of roughly 8 knots, she suits extended itineraries such as the Great Loop or Bahamas cruising. Underway she offers a steady, full displacement motion that many find reassuring in a seaway; owners note that short, wind driven chop of 2–3 ft is handled with routine control, and at least one refitted 53 has

been described by its owner as “ready to cross any ocean today.”

Aboard, the full beam amidships master stateroom, fine teak and cherry joinery, and a salon with an integrated galley receive consistent commendation for liveability. The pilothouse is praised for its sightlines and well placed handholds, though one reviewer pointed out the spiral stair to the lower foyer as a potential safety issue. Engine room access through the master foyer door is convenient for owner maintenance. Power arrangements vary: many examples feature twin Cummins installations, while some earlier boats were twins and later versions were fitted with a single main engine plus an optional wing. Routine systems upkeep is part of ownership—items like Tecma toilet controller replacements appear in owner discussions—and active stabilizer service and other hydraulic work are recurring maintenance themes. Haul outs and bottom maintenance on a 53 are noticeably costlier than on smaller yachts; one documented three year refit approached roughly USD 250,000, a useful benchmark when planning budgets for older boats.

Pros and Cons

- Ocean capable endurance of roughly 2,000+ nm at about 8 kt, enabling genuine long distance cruising.
- A stable, predictable full displacement motion that stays composed in short, steep sea states.
- Comfortable interior arrangements with a full beam amidships master, quality joinery, and an ergonomic pilothouse.
- Not designed for speed; performance is tuned for efficient 8–9 knot passagemaking rather than fast runs.
- Active stabilizer maintenance and hydraulic systems can require regular attention and expense.
- Ownership costs trend higher, with significant haul outs/bottom work bills and the possibility of substantial refits on older examples.
