OVERVIEW

FREEDOM by SES CUSTOM is a 144 ft (43.89 m) motor yacht built on an aluminum hull. She provides a 20 knot cruise (23.02 mph) with a 22 knot top end (25.32 mph), offers accommodations for 12 guests, and registers 399 GT.

Selecting a FREEDOM

If your brief calls for a roomy, quick yacht within the motor yachts class that benefits from an aluminum hull, FREEDOM is a strong contender. Questions and Answers

Q: What is the cruising and top speed of FREEDOM? A: The **cruising speed** is 20 kn (23.02 mph) and the **maximum speed** is 22 kn (25.32 mph).

Q: What type of yacht is it, and what is the hull made of? A: It's a motor yacht in the motor yachts segment constructed with an **aluminum hull** and featuring an aluminum deck.

Q: Who designed the yacht? A: Both the **hull** and **interior** were penned by Too Design - Marco Casali.

Q: What engines power the yacht? A: Propulsion is provided by **2 x Caterpillar Inboard Diesel** engines, offering reliable performance and straightforward serviceability.

Q: How many people can it accommodate, and what are the service spaces? A: The yacht offers **accommodations for 12** , with **8 heads** and **3 crew cabins** , and is supported by **9246 gal** of fuel and **2113 gal** of fresh water for extended range and endurance.

Owner Experience Review

As of June 2, 2026, we were unable to locate owner testimonials, forum posts, or expert reviews specific to a vessel named FREEDOM manufactured by SES CUSTOM. There are no published first hand notes on handling, nor are there cabin, galley, or ergonomics observations or long term maintenance discussions tied to this particular build.

For perspective only, other yachts carrying the "Freedom" name occupy different market niches: the CCN 27 m Freedom (2018) was covered for high speed capability (roughly 40 kt top and about 34 kt cruising on triple waterjets), suggesting a sportier, close to the sea experience; owners of

Freedom sailboats (36/40 series) often applaud their freestanding carbon rigs — comments such as “the first reef is built in” and “no shrouds, no stays” describe predictable depowering behavior. These examples relate to distinct designs and should not be interpreted as specifications or performance indicators for FREEDOM.

Public brokerage listings do show that SES CUSTOM undertakes custom builds across a range of lengths and styles, which speaks to the yard’s bespoke capability; however, we have not found layout plans or comfort reviews tied directly to FREEDOM. Press pieces and other listings for unrelated “Freedom” yachts sometimes point out owner privacy layouts (for example, a full beam owner’s suite on the main deck aft of the helm) and generous social cockpits — these make useful comparison points when evaluating space planning aboard, but they do not provide direct evidence for this model.

Pros and Cons

- Public listings confirm SES CUSTOM delivers custom projects, showing the yard’s ability to produce bespoke builds.
- Other yachts named “Freedom” offer context for potential use cases, ranging from high speed sport cruising (CCN 27 m) to short handed sailing (Freedom 36/40).
- External articles about different “Freedom” yachts highlight owner focused layouts and large social cockpit arrangements that can act as benchmarks when assessing onboard planning.
- No owner, forum, or expert reports for an SES CUSTOM FREEDOM were found as of June 2, 2026.
- There are no documented on water handling reports specific to this SES CUSTOM FREEDOM.
- No owner feedback concerning accommodation layouts or long term maintenance for this model is currently available.
