With a maximum draft of 10.936 ft (3.3333 m), one head, and a composite deck atop a fiberglass and plastic hull, the model offers a practical blend of performance and uncomplicated systems. Owner Experience Review

Owners and professional skippers who operate the 44 Open from SOLARIS YACHTS typically use it in the ways test reports indicate: as an elegant dayboat suited to social raft ups, a practical weekend cruiser with true overnight abilities, and a high end tender for larger yachts. Sea trials and owner feedback describe a composed, confidence inspiring ride; the hull soaks up chop without fuss, tracks cleanly at speed, and demonstrated good manners in 3 ft rollers and the kind of chop found in Biscayne Bay. Published cruise numbers are consistent across reviews, pointing to an economical and comfortable sweet spot in the low to mid 20 knot band, paired with brisk acceleration and effortless joystick docking when fitted with Volvo Penta IPS.

The deck is laid out for sociability: fold out bulwarks widen the cockpit, fore and aft sunpads create generous lounging space, and the midship seating converts neatly into a dining configuration. Below deck, two sleeping berths and a capacious head make short overnight trips practical, and reviewers frequently noted the interior feels roomy for a 44 foot platform. At the helm, three seats, unobstructed sightlines, and an ergonomic layout beneath a carbon T top support long passages at the wheel. Those advantages come with compromises: the design prioritizes openness over protection from the elements, test examples often lacked windscreen wipers, and specific options (for example, boats without rear doors) will affect all weather usability.

From a maintenance and ownership perspective, access to machinery spaces and the level of finish receive high marks; accounts highlight a sizable, well organized engine room with neat installations. Published fuel consumption and range estimates at typical cruise settings clustered around roughly 220–228 nautical miles with conservative reserves, which aligns with the boat's intended weekending role. The IPS pod arrangement rewards owners with simplified maneuvering but commonly ties servicing and diagnostics to the Volvo Penta dealer network. One noteworthy safety/access point from testing: a boat was evaluated without an emergency escape hatch below decks; prospective buyers should verify the specific build details on their vessel.

Pros and Cons

- Smooth, stable ride in chop with real world seakeeping validated by multiple tests.
- Open deck plan with fold out bulwarks, big sunpads, and convertible dining is ideal for dayboating and raft ups.
- IPS joystick and DPS simplify close quarters handling and docking.
- Open concept limits weather protection, and test boats lacked windscreen

wipers.

- IPS pods typically require dealer level Volvo Penta service and support.
- A test boat lacked an emergency escape hatch below, so build specific access should be verified.
