# OVERVIEW

---

The 57 RS from SOUTHERLY is a sail yacht engineered as a performance sailboat built on a robust fiberglass and plastic hull. Represented internationally by Andrey Shestakov and Shestakov Yacht Sales, the design merges performance-oriented sailing with comfortable, practical cruising accommodations.

## Selecting a 57 RS

---

Opt for the 57 RS when you want a well-proportioned combination of size, seaworthiness, and efficiency. With an LOA of 58 ft (17.73 m) and a beam of 17 ft (5.21 m), the platform offers substantial interior volume without compromising maneuverability. Its broad draft flexibility between 11.483–34.449 ft (3.5–10.5 m) widens your cruising geography, while a single inboard Yanmar diesel keeps propulsion simple to operate and maintain. Accommodation for 4 and two heads makes the layout suitable for couples, families, or a small professional crew.

## Questions and Answers

---

Q: What type of yacht is the 57 RS? A: It's a sail yacht arranged as a performance sailboat constructed from fiberglass and plastic to provide durability and efficient performance.

Q: What are the key dimensions and draft range? A: LOA measures 58 ft (17.73

m), the beam is 17 ft (5.21 m), and the **draft** spans from 11.483 ft (3.5 m) up to 34.449 ft (10.5 m).

Q: What powers the yacht? A: Propulsion is provided by a single **inboard Yanmar** diesel engine, offering reliable and maintainable power.

Q: How many people can sleep aboard and how many heads are there? A: The interior is arranged to **sleep 4** and includes **2 heads** , making it suitable for couples, families, or a small crew configuration.

## Owner Experience Review

---

Owners are attracted to the 57 RS from SOUTHERLY because it uniquely combines long range passagemaking with genuine shallow water capability. The swing keel allows access to secluded anchorages and beaching at approximately 3'6" when retracted; with the keel deployed, the twin canted rudders and the 7,385 lb cast iron foil provide confident control and steady tracking. Sea trials report efficient performance upwind at roughly 30–35° apparent, achieving 6–7 knots in 7–10 knots of true wind, and the hull carries through short chop with ease. Owners and online discussions also mention that the push button sailhandling systems make single handing a realistic option for experienced skippers. Below deck, the raised saloon benefits from large windows that give everyone seated good sightlines, and the adaptable three or four cabin layouts (with choices such as an aft master or a dinghy garage) accommodate either owner operators or those running a crewed program.

The tradeoff is added complexity. Multiple level changes create a more

interrupted fore and aft flow, and reviewers caution that the boat's systems are sophisticated with some confined access areas. The swing/raising keel needs routine attention: owners advise annual inspection of the lifting pennant and bolts, with maintenance access through removable keel trunk panels, and the cast iron keel should be checked periodically for corrosion and bedding condition. A number of owners have chosen to re-engine or specify alternate diesel packages. For many buyers, the 57 RS delivers long distance capability together with shallow water freedom—while requiring a realistic maintenance plan.

## Pros and Cons

- Swing keel enables true shoal draft cruising, allowing anchoring in about 3'6" with the keel retracted.
- Strong upwind performance and steady handling, maintaining composure in short chop with twin canted rudders and the heavy swing keel down.
- Push button sailhandling and integrated systems make single handing feasible for seasoned sailors.
- The raising keel mechanism requires regular inspection and servicing, including checks of the lifting pennant and bolts.
- Complex systems and some tight access points can increase the time and effort required for maintenance.
- Multiple interior level changes produce a more segmented traffic flow fore and aft.
