OVERVIEW

For owners in search of a capable 30-foot center-console, the SOUTHPORT 30 FE pairs sensible proportions with a time-tested build philosophy. Listed as a motor yacht in the center-console segment, it sits on a sturdy fiberglass and plastic hull and is driven by twin Mercury outboards using gasoline. When buyers evaluate the 30-foot category they typically weigh cockpit room, ownership simplicity, and cruising reach. The 30 FE answers those needs with a 30 ft (9.14 m) LOA and a broad 10 ft (3.18 m) beam, and its twin Mercury Outboards (Gas) deliver straightforward performance and ease of maintenance. With 232 gallons of fuel and 20 gallons of freshwater aboard, the model is configured for full days offshore on a contemporary center-console platform. - Generous 232-gallon fuel capacity supports extended outings, while a 20-gallon water tank covers onboard needs.

- Q: What are the overall dimensions? A: The 30 FE measures **LOA** 30 ft (9.14 m) with a **beam** of 10 ft (3.18 m).
- Q: What powers the boat? A: Power comes from **twin engines** by **Mercury** , specified as **Outboard** units running on **Gas** .

- Q: How is the boat classified? A: It is listed as a motor yacht in a center console layout and rides on a fiberglass and plastic hull.
- Q: What are the onboard capacities? A: **Fuel capacity** is 232 gallons and **water capacity** is 20 gallons.

Owner Experience Review

Owners familiar with the 30 FE from SOUTHPORT commonly use it as a combined family and fishing platform. The Family Edition layout is designed for day cruising and beach runs, featuring reversible forward seating that converts to a sunpad, a comfortable console cabin, and an enclosed head; many owners add the optional entertainment package with a grill and refrigerator for extra weekend convenience. For a 30-footer the deck plan feels spacious fore and aft, with broad gunwales, mezzanine seating, and swim platforms aft that ease transitions between relaxing and working the lines.

On the water, users and dealers highlight steady, predictable handling thanks to the 30 FE's deep-V hull and pronounced bow flare, which reduce spray and mellow the ride in choppy seas. The cockpit is outfitted for offshore tasks with in-deck storage and an insulated transom fishbox, yet the boat can also handle longer passages when fitted appropriately: reports of the Volvo Penta D6 sterndrive DPI setup indicate about 2.5 mpg and an approximate 400-mile range at roughly 42 mph, and listings note extended-trip capability with larger fuel tanks and the diesel option. Maintenance reports are pragmatic—no widespread, model-specific failures are reported—but ownership experience depends on propulsion choice: twin outboards are simpler to maintain, while the D6 sterndrive with duoprop/DPI/joystick introduces added mechanical complexity and requires thoughtful service access even as it preserves a clean

stern for fishing.

Pros and Cons

- Smooth, confident ride in rough water thanks to the wide bow flare and deep-V hull.
- Versatile family-and-fishing layout with convertible forward seating, spacious cockpits, and dedicated fishboxes.
- With the Volvo Penta D6 sterndrive and larger fuel, reports note ~2.5 mpg and ~400-mile range at ~42 mph.
- The sterndrive configuration adds DPI/duoprop/joystick service complexity versus twin outboards.
- Maximizing range for longer trips typically requires the diesel sterndrive and larger tanks.
- Sterndrive service access needs planning, while outboards offer simpler routine access.
