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OVERVIEW

The 60DH from SPIRIT YACHTS fuses traditional boatbuilding artistry with contemporary sailing capability. Offered through Shestakov Yacht Sales with broker Andrey Shestakov, this sophisticated sailing yacht is presented as an elegant sloop built on a classic wooden hull.

Opting for the 60DH prioritizes enduring lines, efficient offshore passagemaking, and interiors that celebrate natural timber. With a draft adjustable between 6.89 and 9.186 ft (2.1–2.8 m), the design balances access to shallower anchorages with deep keel stability for open-water work. - Q: What type of yacht is the 60DH? A: It's a **performance-focused** sailing yacht laid out as a **classic** sloop and finished with an artisanal wooden hull.
- Q: What are the key dimensions and draft of the 60DH? A: **Dimensions** list a 60 ft (18.3 m) LOA with a 14 ft (4.3 m) beam. **Draft** varies from 6.89 ft (2.1 m) up to 9.186 ft (2.8 m), giving flexibility for different cruising grounds.

Owner Experience Review

Owners are often attracted to the 60DH from SPIRIT YACHTS for single- or short handed offshore passages, private owner and guest cruising, and occasional classic-regatta participation. The setup is intentionally manageable for small crews—many examples include electric reefing and rod rigging that reduce loads and simplify sail handling.

Under sail the yacht is reported to be lively and engaging, with particularly good performance in light airs and owner/press accounts of 16 knot surges when conditions permit. The vessel's seakeeping feels secure for its classic deckhouse proportions, though the motion character is more reminiscent of traditional designs than the flatter motions of modern wide beam cruisers.

Down below the deckhouse layout and owner-focused cabin arrangements are described as comfortable for extended periods aboard, typically in a three cabin format that maintains privacy for owners and guests. The high quality varnished timber interior is a signature feature that requires routine attention, and some owners note that living below in heavy weather can feel more classic than optimally practical.

Maintenance realities reflect the wood/epoxy construction and the specification level of onboard systems: specialist surveyors are advisable, attention to watertight penetration sealing is critical, and lifecycle budgets should account for significant costs. One well documented 2024–2025 refit exceeded €200,000 covering new standing and running rigging, sails, a battery bank, a full hull repaint, and comprehensive systems servicing.

Pros and Cons

- Designed for extended, short handed voyaging with helm friendly systems.
- Excellent light air performance with responsive and exciting handling.
- Premium interior joinery and a deckhouse layout that support prolonged onboard living.
- Varnished wood joinery and finishes require steady maintenance and care.
- Motion characteristics and below decks practicality in heavy seas are more traditional than those of modern beamy cruisers.
- Wood/epoxy construction and high spec systems necessitate specialist surveys and can lead to substantial refit expenditures.
