Q1: What type of yacht is the Iconic DA 50? A1: It is a high end offering in the motor yacht class within the motor yachts segment, manufactured by STEELER YACHTS.

Q2: What powers the yacht? A2: Propulsion comes from twin **inboard diesel** engines supplied by **Volvo Penta** , chosen for dependable performance and

operational efficiency.

Q3: What are the key dimensions? A3: The vessel measures 50 ft (15.24 m) LOA with a 14 ft (4.42 m) beam, offering a scaled footprint for steady handling and comfortable interiors.

Q4: What materials are used in construction? A4: The hull is classified as fiberglass/plastic while the **deck** is finished in **fiberglass**, combining longevity with straightforward upkeep.

Owner Experience Review

Owners and test crews often describe the Iconic DA 50 from STEELER YACHTS as a multi-role platform well suited to family coastal cruising and weekend escapes, as well as day boating and entertaining. Its presentation to the U.S. market via dealer demonstrations and the Miami Boat Show 2024 has highlighted the layout's support for short cruises, including two double cabins and four berths.

When afloat, the model is reported to perform as a high-speed cruiser; press reports reference an aluminum hull and a low center of gravity that reduce spray, with a quoted top speed near 43 mph. Many installations employ twin Volvo Penta IPS systems (for example, D8 IPS 800 in specification sheets), which provide joystick control for intuitive close-quarters handling.

Independent reviewers have praised the broader Steeler 50 family as visually exceptional with "bulletproof" construction—comments that reflect the brand's reputation for robust seakeeping.

Interior feedback highlights a luminous saloon with expansive glazing and a

retractable glass roof, accompanied by a galley and a single head in the standard arrangement. The fitout is marketed as “luxury for the US market,” and the generous fuel capacity together with CE offshore classification supports longer coastal runs. Owners should plan for realistic maintenance: IPS drives require diligent, and at times costly, servicing and can generate dealer/warranty complications; the aluminum hull benefits from strict anode management and sound galvanic protection. Steeler’s intensive paint and finish protocols and independent paint surveys are strengths, but routine care of coatings and hardware remains important.

Pros and Cons

- High performance aluminum hull and low center of gravity deliver a confident, relatively dry ride with ≈43 mph top speed.
- Twin Volvo Penta IPS with joystick control simplifies docking and close quarters maneuvering.
- Two double cabins, a bright panoramic saloon with a retractable roof, and offshore oriented range support family cruising and entertaining.
- IPS installations require attentive, sometimes costly maintenance, with occasional service/warranty frustrations reported.
- Aluminum hull ownership demands vigilant anode management, galvanic protection, and regular underwater inspections.
- Standard layout with a single head and two cabins can limit convenience for larger crews on longer trips.

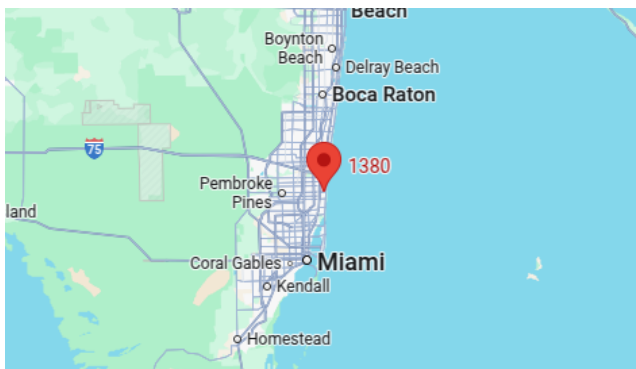
