Owner Experience Review

Owners commonly use the 195 Ls by STINGRAY for family day excursions and tow-sports such as waterskiing and tubing; some owners also enjoy light fishing when the boat layout includes a livewell. Reports and listings highlight assured handling and lively acceleration; versions with the 4.3L sterndrive are frequently cited with top speeds in the mid-40s to over 50 mph.

Handling nuances appear repeatedly in owner feedback: several owners note a tendency to porpoise around 30–35 mph unless the drive is fully trimmed down or the boat is fitted with trim tabs. Many resolve this by installing Smart Tabs or similar trim-tab systems. At displacement or no-wake velocities, a number of owners mention the boat can track unevenly from the stern, necessitating minor steering adjustments.

Onboard, the cockpit is often described as spacious for a roughly 19' bowrider, featuring hi-lo jump seats and configurable seating that enable adaptable passenger arrangements and practical under-seat storage. Cuddy-cabin variants serve for occasional overnighting for two, offering a compact V-berth and room for a porta-potti. A large number of boats are powered by MerCruiser 4.3 or Volvo V6 sterndrives; owners reference routine 4.3 V6 maintenance tasks and note that isolated engine problems have been reported on some used boats—making a pre-purchase survey advisable. Many 19x models from STINGRAY include a gas-assisted engine hatch that eases regular service access.

Pros and Cons

- Owners report brisk off-the-mark acceleration and confident ride characteristics.
- The adaptable cockpit with hi-lo jump seats and ample under-seat storage is

well suited to family day use.

- The model works well for watersports and, in certain layouts with a livewell, light fishing tasks.
- The boat can porpoise around 30–35 mph unless the drive is trimmed down or trim tabs are installed.
- At slow speeds it may track irregularly from the stern, requiring small, frequent course corrections.
- Some used boats with 4.3 V6 engines have exhibited engine concerns, so a thorough pre purchase inspection is recommended.
