OVERVIEW

The GULET from SU MARINE is a 105 ft motorsailer built on a wooden hull with a full displacement form to ensure confident, economical passagemaking. Listed by Andrey Shestakov of Shestakov Yacht Sales, it sits in the wider sail yacht class and is marketed specifically as a motorsailer.

Selecting a GULET

Opting for the GULET means choosing a vessel that blends traditional craftsmanship from SU MARINE with practical seagoing capability. At 105 ft (32 m) LOA, with a 24 ft (7.35 m) beam and a draft between 9.514–10.171 ft (2.9–3.1 m), the proportions favor roomy living spaces and stable behavior under way. Twin Iveco inboard diesels deliver a comfortable cruising pace of 10 kn and a top end near 12 kn. Constructed with a wooden yacht hull and full displacement lines, this model prioritizes dependable motion at sea. Questions and Answers

Q: What type of yacht is the GULET? A: It is offered as a motorsailer within the general sail yacht class, constructed on a wooden hull. The design emphasizes a **full-displacement** platform to ensure calm, predictable performance.

Q: What are the key dimensions and tonnage? A: The **LOA** measures 105 ft (32 m), the **beam** is 24 ft (7.35 m), and the **draft** varies from 9.514–10.171 ft (2.9–3.1 m). The vessel's **Gross Tonnage** is 132 GT.

Q: What powers the yacht and how fast does it go? A: **Engines:** 2 x Iveco, **inboard diesel** . The yacht cruises comfortably at 10 kn (11.51 mph) and can reach a **maximum speed** of 12 kn (13.81 mph).

Q: How many people can stay aboard? A: The yacht provides **accommodation** for 14 people with **sleeps** for 12, allowing flexible guest and crew arrangements.

Q: Who designed the hull and who represents the sale? A: **Hull designer** : HASAN ALI BAYAR; **interior designer** : N/A. The GULET is presented for sale by Andrey Shestakov and the brokerage team at Shestakov Yacht Sales, and is built by SU MARINE.

Owner Experience Review

Owners choose the GULET from SU MARINE for the exact cruising profile it delivers: crewed charters and relaxed island to island passages around Greece and Turkey, as well as extended family coastal trips. The adaptable interior plans—commonly 5–7 cabins with ensuite facilities—work well for hosting 8–12 guests, while the social flow typically centers on a generous open foredeck for daytime lounging and a shaded aft dining area for lengthy meals at anchor or underway. Interiors commonly display warm, traditional finishes

with fine timber joinery on many examples, underlining the yacht's hospitality orientation.

Underway, owners report a calm, displacement style motion that handles standard Aegean conditions with composure. These gulets are not built for speed; 35 m variants generally cruise between ~9–11 knots. Construction across the model range can include steel hulls as well as cold moulded wood hulls with wood/epoxy superstructures, contributing to the substantial, heavy displacement feel and classic handling characteristics. Owners frequently note a close, collaborative build process with SU MARINE, which supports a bespoke outcome for each GULET.

Maintenance reflects the chosen materials and the yacht's role. For wooden builds, hull and superstructure brightwork require routine varnishing and occasional refit or repaint cycles—tasks seasoned wooden yacht owners expect as part of long term care. Diesel mains and auxiliary generators (specified differently across individual boats) need regular servicing and survey attention, so buyers should budget for ongoing mechanical maintenance in addition to cosmetic work. While details differ from one custom gulet to another, the operational profile across the range remains consistent: comfortable entertaining and reliable coastal range rather than high speed.

Pros and Cons

- Steady displacement motion delivers a comfortable ride in typical Aegean seas.
- Large foredeck and covered aft dining spaces are ideal for charter operations and family cruises.
- Versatile accommodation layouts, often 5–7 ensuite cabins, support hosting 8–12 guests comfortably.
- Not designed for high performance; handling favors traditional response over

sporty agility.

- Wood built examples require regular brightwork care, periodic refits, and repainting.
- Typical cruise of ~9–11 knots on 35 m examples means slower passage times versus faster yacht types.
