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OVERVIEW

Introducing the DX20 by SUNDANCE BOATS INC — a compact motor yacht designed with a practical center-console layout and built on a sturdy steel hull. Measuring 19 ft (5.99 m) overall with a 7 ft (2.34 m) beam and powered by a single Yamaha outboard running on gas, it aims to provide straightforward, enjoyable days on the water with minimal complexity.

Selecting a DX20

Opt for the DX20 when you want an uncluttered, walk around deck and low-maintenance ownership. The center-console design gives unobstructed sightlines and simple movement around the helm, while the steel construction adds long term durability. Positioned in the motor-yacht category, it packs practical capability into a compact, easy-to-handle package.

Q: What are the dimensions of the DX20? A: The **LOA** measures 19 ft (5.99 m) and the **beam** is 7 ft (2.34 m).

Q: Who is the builder of the DX20? A: The **builder** is SUNDANCE BOATS INC.

Q: What engine setup does it have and what fuel does it use? A: The **engine**

configuration is a single Yamaha **outboard** , and the **fuel** type is gas.

Q: What materials are used for the hull and deck? A: The **hull** is constructed of steel, while the **deck** is Stainless Steel.

Q: What type of boat is it categorized as? A: It's a center-console platform within the motor-yacht class, with a hull listed under the steel-yacht category.

Owner Experience Review

Owners commonly characterize the DX20 from SUNDANCE BOATS INC as a go to inshore skiff that splits time between flats fishing and family sandbar or weekend cruising. The fully open 360° deck facilitates fishing from any angle and makes moving kids and gear around the boat effortless; the design includes fold down aft seats beside a livewell and a leaning post that can swivel aft to keep an eye on the action.

The all composite, no wood construction gets frequent praise from owners for eliminating rot concerns and reducing long term maintenance headaches. On the water the DX20 behaves like a larger skiff—owners report a soft, dry inshore ride—although conditions with swells or chop above roughly two feet can make the ride noticeably firmer. A Yamaha performance test using an F115LB recorded a top speed of 40.5 mph and about 33.7 mph at 5000 rpm; that trial was with a tunnel hull setup and the ventilation plate positioned 4.5 inches above the bottom. Many owners install a jack plate to push into extremely shallow water, further extending the boat's inshore versatility.

Everyday ownership is uncomplicated, following standard outboard service intervals (Yamaha and Suzuki are common choices). Forums advise used boat shoppers to inspect gelcoat for chips or cracks and to assess the quality of any repairs. Trailering is routine for many owners—one reported towing a DX20 20–30 times annually—and finished rigs (boat, motor, trailer) commonly fall in

the roughly 3,500–5,500 lb range, so matching vehicle towing capacity and trailer components is important.

Pros and Cons

- Versatile for inshore fishing, as well as sandbar and weekend family cruising.
- Delivers a soft, dry inshore ride for a skiff and reached a Yamaha tested top speed of 40.5 mph with an F115LB.
- No wood composite construction, plus a 360° deck layout with fold down aft seats, livewell, and an aft facing leaning post.
- The ride can become rough in swells or chop exceeding about two feet.
- Accessing very shallow water is frequently aided by a jack plate, which requires extra expense and installation.
- Used boats may show gelcoat chips or cracks; careful inspection of past repairs is recommended.
