OVERVIEW

Presented by Shestakov Yacht Sales and broker Andrey Shestakov, the DX22 from SUNDANCE BOATS INC is a motor yacht in a center-console configuration built on a fiberglass and plastic hull. Powered by a single Yamaha outboard (gas), it's arranged for straightforward, efficient days on the water.

Selecting a DX22

Opting for the DX22 means choosing a compact vessel that still offers practical capability: 22 ft (6.71 m) LOA, 7 ft (2.39 m) beam and a 1.64 ft (0.5 m) draft. The center-console format with a single Yamaha outboard (gas) simplifies ownership and operation. The hull is built using fiberglass and plastic construction and the deck is finished in fiberglass for durability and ease of maintenance.

Features of the Model

- Layout: center-console layout providing an uncluttered helm and easy walk around access
- Construction: Hull fashioned from fiberglass and plastic with a fiberglass deck
- Propulsion: Single Yamaha outboard; fuel type is gas
- Dimensions: LOA 22 ft (6.71 m), beam 7 ft (2.39 m), draft 1.64 ft (0.5 m)
- Fuel: 33 gallons for efficient day runs

Owner Experience Review

Owners of the DX22 from SUNDANCE BOATS INC commonly describe it as a versatile day boat that bridges inshore and nearshore uses: a capable fishing platform with dual livewells, rod storage and casting decks, while also serving family outings with roomy forward seating and large aft jump seats. One owner characterized it as "great for both fishing and family fun," and a magazine sea trial observed it "stayed remarkably dry" in blustery conditions. Practical experience suggests the ride can become firm once swells or wind chop exceed roughly two feet.

Onboard commentary highlights comfortable forward companion seating, a swing back helm/cooler seat and substantial aft flip up seating, plus plentiful under deck and console storage; the forward insulated livewell often doubles as a drink cooler. There's an integrated swim platform and ample rod stowage, with an interior finish frequently called "premium" for a utility skiff.

Maintenance tends to be straightforward: common outboard choices such as a Yamaha F115 or Suzuki 140 simplify routine service, and owners report easy console and wiring access for adding a trolling motor or GPS. There are few widely reported model specific failures and long term data is limited; when evaluating used boats, inspect popular optional systems like hydraulic steering, a jack plate (for skinny water performance), and trim/tilt components.

Pros and Cons

- Versatile for inshore/nearshore fishing and family cruising.
- Reported to remain remarkably dry for a skiff in windy conditions.
- Well-thought-out layout with comfortable seating, generous storage, a forward livewell that doubles as a cooler, and an integrated swim platform.
- Ride can become rough when swells or wind chop build beyond about 2 feet.
- Publicly available long term owner data is limited.

- Optional systems on used examples (hydraulic steering, jack plate, trim/tilt) are common inspection and service points.
