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## OVERVIEW

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The Convertible with tuna tower from SUNNY BRIGGS is a dedicated sport fisherman motor yacht outfitted with a tall tuna tower to maximize sightlines. Developed around a Glenn Haught hull, it pairs a fiberglass hull with a Composite deck and twin inboard Detroit Diesel power for secure offshore performance and reliable, efficient **diesel** operation.

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If your objective is serious gamefishing while retaining onboard comfort, the Convertible with tuna tower presents a strong option. With a 50 ft (15.24 m) LOA and a 17 ft (5.41 m) beam, it delivers the deck space and stability crews expect; an 800-gallon fuel reserve and 150-gallon freshwater tank allow extended runs on productive grounds. This model sits squarely in the sport fisherman niche of the wider motor yacht category, designed for anglers who prioritize heightened sightlines and functional proportions.

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Q: What defines the Convertible with tuna tower as a sportfishing platform? A: It's a dedicated sport fisherman equipped with a prominent **tuna tower** , built on a balanced **50 ft LOA** and **17 ft beam** , and set on a **fiberglass hull** intended for robust offshore work.

Q: What propulsion does it use? A: The model is driven by **twin Detroit Diesel** powerplants mounted **Inboard** and running on **Diesel** , selected for durability and straightforward maintenance.

Q: Who designed the hull and who builds the boat? A: The hull was penned by **Glenn Haught** , and the vessel is constructed by **SUNNY BRIGGS** , a yard known for serious sport fisherman designs.

Q: What are the primary construction materials? A: The hull is fashioned from fiberglass with a **Composite** deck—an arrangement chosen for structural integrity, stiffness, and longevity.

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## Owner Experience Review

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Owners commonly describe the Convertible with tuna tower from SUNNY BRIGGS as a true sportfisher that still serves well for family weekends. The expansive cockpit, integrated transom live well/fish box, and mezzanine-style deck flow are well suited to bluewater tuna work and offshore gamefishing; many of these boats are operated privately or in day-charter service. With listed fuel capacity near 800 gallons, owners position the design for extended

passages in addition to relaxed cruising.

Sea trials and professional notes highlight a light, stiff, quiet cold molded hull. The Carolina entry combined with a broad beam contributes to a soft, seakindly motion, consistent tracking, and a steady helm at cruising RPMs; operating from the tuna tower's upper station provides stable spotting and fighting capability rather than outright top-end sprinting. It's not built as a blisteringly fast sportsboat, but it excels at comfortable, confidence-inspiring offshore cruising speeds.

Accommodations include a forward master with an athwartships queen and private head/shower, a separate guest stateroom with a second head, and a galley down layout with a salon furnished by two freestanding sofas that include storage—making multi-day outings practical. Owners note typical cold molded maintenance—watching wood cores, periodic topside repainting, and window re bedding—along with routine service items such as turbo and exhaust manifold work and generator upkeep; systems are accessed via a conventional aft engine room fitted with dripless shaft logs and a factory-installed fire suppression system. As the builder remarks, “There is a difference between just getting a boat out, and getting a good boat out . . . Remember that.”

## Pros and Cons

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- Soft, quiet, seakindly ride from the Carolina entry and wide beam inspires confidence offshore.
- Huge cockpit, transom live well/fish box, and full tuna tower deliver strong fishability and sighting.
- Two cabins, two heads, and a galley down salon make weekend cruising straightforward.
- Not a high speed sportboat and is best enjoyed at comfortable cruising

RPMs.

- Cold molded construction benefits from routine monitoring and periodic paint/window re bedding.
- Older boats may require engine and generator service, including turbos and exhaust manifolds.
