## OVERVIEW

---

The 40 Open from SUNREEF is a performance oriented motor yacht catamaran designed on a wide 22 ft beam and a dependable multi hull platform built of fiberglass and plastic. Represented by Shestakov Yacht Sales and broker Andrey Shestakov, this model fuses top speeds up to 55 kn with practical onboard arrangements for memorable days afloat.

### Selecting a 40 Open

---

Deciding on a 40 Open is grounded in measurable attributes: a 43 ft (13.11 m) LOA combined with a 22 ft (6.74 m) beam that deliver internal volume and inherent stability; a catamaran multi hull form; and twin Mercury powerplants for sharp, responsive performance. As both a motor yacht and a true catamaran, it appeals to buyers who prioritize nimble handling, expansive deck real estate, and rapid passages, while the fiberglass and plastic hull and composite deck emphasize robustness and fuel efficiency.

## Questions and Answers

---

Q: What type of yacht is the 40 Open? A: It's a motor yacht catamaran with a Multi Hull layout and a fiberglass and plastic hull.

Q: What are the key dimensions? A: The 40 Open has an LOA of 43 ft (13.11 m), a beam of 22 ft (6.74 m), and a draft range of 7.382–7.655 ft (2.25–2.3333 m). These figures define its footprint and **stability** .

Q: How fast can it go and what is the cruise speed? A: The 40 Open reaches a **maximum speed** of 55 kn (63.29 mph) and a **cruise speed** of 15 kn (17.26 mph).

Q: What powers the boat? A: Twin ( **2** ) Mercury engines running on **Gas/Petrol** provide responsive performance and straightforward serviceability.

Q: Who are the builder and designers? A: The yacht is built by SUNREEF, with both **hull** and **interior** design by Sunreef Yachts. For acquisition support, Shestakov Yacht Sales and **Andrey Shestakov** are your dedicated contacts.

## Owner Experience Review

---

Owners and operators typically deploy the 40 Open from SUNREEF as a rapid day boat, a tender for larger yachts, or a charter platform, with many half and full day trips receiving consistently positive guest reactions. The broad hull spacing, fold out aft bulwarks that enlarge the cockpit while anchored, and substantial aft sun pad stowage make it an effective base for watersports and storing toys. Forward, the bow dining module converts into a compact cabin that owners report is adequate for occasional overnights or a short weekend. Helm stations are commonly praised as sheltered and technologically advanced, featuring modern touchscreen controls, and charter clients have described the vessel as "beautiful, clean, modern and very convenient," adding that it provides "a real comfortable ride to discover the beautiful greece with pleasure."

On the water, builders and specialist reviews point to a planing non foil configuration with an approximate top end near ~35 kt in IPS inboard form; promotional trials and press pieces claim hydrofoil/outboard setups can achieve around ~50–60 kt. Test reports and user commentary often characterise the platform as naturally balanced and steady at speed, with foils reported to deploy at roughly ~25 kt to lift the hulls and lower drag. The model

is framed as an innovative, high speed day cruiser rather than a dedicated long range passagemaker.

Feedback from owners is mixed regarding finishing and delivery schedules. Forum accounts note workmanship shortcomings — for example, "the wiring was very sloppy," — alongside extended delivery waits (reported at 12–24+ months) and at least one refund dispute containing the remark: "we dont have the money to refund you until we sell the boat to someone else." Conversely, commercial charter operators running the 40 Open often receive high scores for upkeep and cleanliness on rental marketplaces, indicating that rigorous professional maintenance can produce strong availability and presentation.

## Pros and Cons

- Expansive deck space with folding aft bulwarks and large sun pad storage suits day use and watersports.
- Convertible bow dining area enables occasional short overnights or weekend stays.
- Reported stability at speed, with hydrofoil/outboard setups claimed up to ~50–60 kt in tests.
- Owner reports cite sloppy wiring and workmanship issues on some builds.
- Documented delivery delays and refund disputes during certain supply chain periods.
- High speed day cruiser concept, not intended as a long range passagemaker.
