OVERVIEW

The 60 Sunreef Power from SUNREEF is a high end motor yacht built as a catamaran on a fiberglass and plastic hull with a composite deck. Presented by Andrey Shestakov and the team at Shestakov Yacht Sales, this model combines roomy accommodations with reliable twin MAN propulsion for confident cruising.

Selecting a 60 Sunreef Power

Opting for the 60 Sunreef Power places emphasis on generous living areas, onboard comfort, and twin engine redundancy. Measuring 80 ft (24.38 m) in LOA with a 35 ft (10.67 m) beam, the power catamaran provides expansive deck real estate and substantial interior volume. Its pair of MAN engines gives owners dependable performance and handling, while the composite deck over a fiberglass and plastic hull ensures durability and straightforward upkeep.

- The yacht is a luxury motor yacht laid out as a catamaran, constructed on a fiberglass and plastic hull with a composite deck.

- The **LOA** measures 80 ft (24.38 m) and the **Beam** measures 35 ft (10.67 m), providing expansive interior and deck volumes.
- Who builds it and what powers it?

Owner Experience Review

Buyers often select the 60 Sunreef Power from SUNREEF for family cruising and owner operated liveaboard use, praising its exceptional interior volume for a vessel in the 60 foot category. Owners note a luminous salon and adaptable layouts that span 3–6 cabins with choices for galley up or galley down arrangements. The generous flybridge, aft deck, and hydraulic swim platform frequently function as a “beach club,” making the model ideal for entertaining, weekend escapes, and charter operations. The design has an earlier generation and a reintroduction around 2020/2021 that was covered in the press, and market listings show examples with both private and ex charter backgrounds.

During sea trials, reports indicate joystick and IPS/pod options give excellent low speed handling and simplified docking, while the broad catamaran stance contributes to a steady, comfortable motion in common cruising conditions. Typical cruising speeds are often reported in the 19–23 knot range, with some older specifications citing higher top speeds; actual performance depends on the chosen engines and equipment package.

Everyday ownership feedback is mixed. Some owners emphasize that some

highly appointed systems and bespoke layouts increase complexity for owner operators. Forum and Reddit discussions mention electrical wiring and systems faults on certain power builds, and several owners feel generators may be undersized for expected hotel loads. There are also conversations about build quality and post contract disputes; experiences vary by individual build and model generation.

Pros and Cons

- Joystick and IPS/pod options offer superior low speed control and simplify docking maneuvers.
- The wide beam catamaran architecture provides a stable and comfortable ride for typical cruising conditions.
- Large interior volume with flexible 3–6 cabin arrangements, an expansive flybridge, and a hydraulic swim platform that doubles as a beach club.
- Some builds have reported electrical wiring and systems issues that required troubleshooting or rework.
- Several owners consider the generators undersized for realistic electrical loads on certain versions.
- Owner forums reference quality concerns and post build/contract disputes that may require additional follow up.

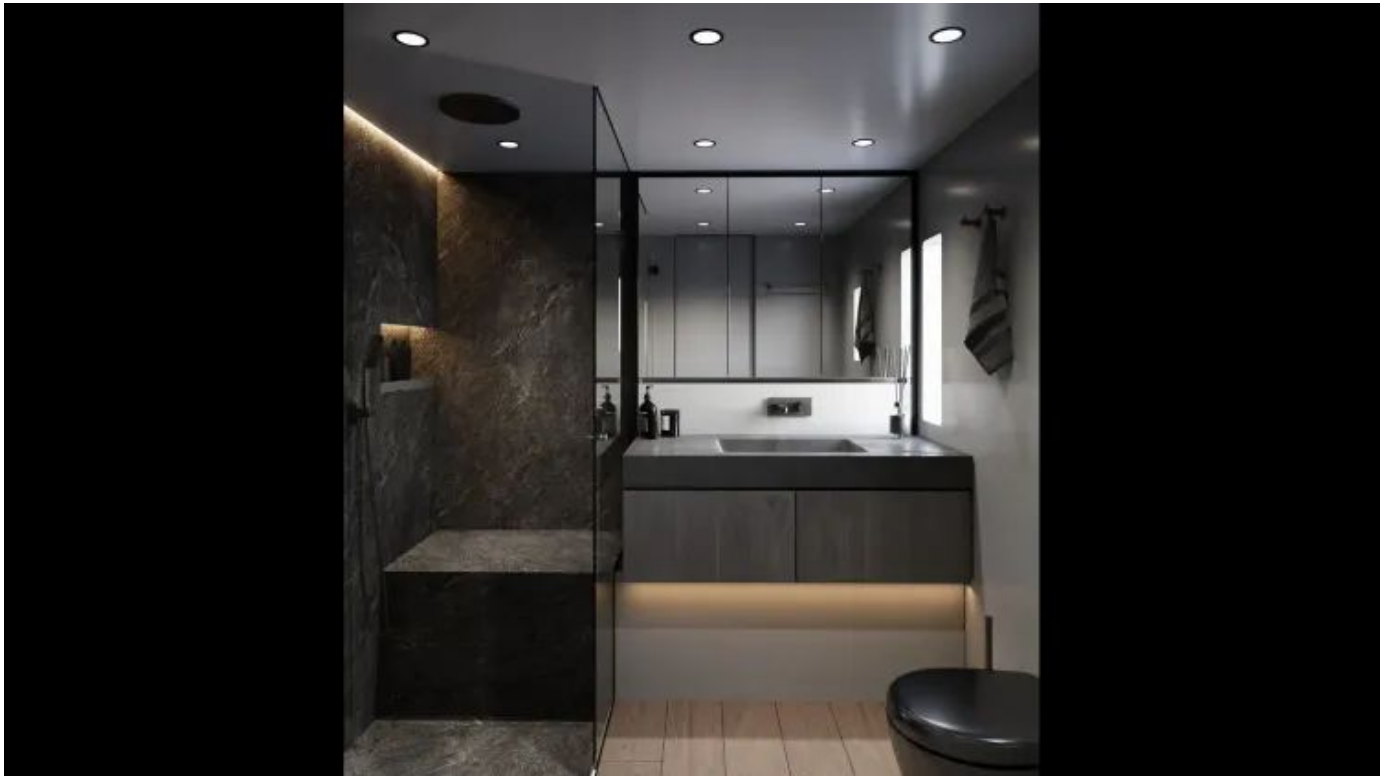
