If your brief calls for a multihull designed for performance and comfortable cruising, the Sunreef 58 Sail delivers the broad 30 ft (9.2 m) beam and shallow minimum draft of 5.413 ft (1.65 m) typical of an able catamaran. Owner Experience Review

Buyers of the Sunreef 58 Sail by SUNREEF most often select it for family cruising under owner operator use, prolonged liveaboard lifestyles, or as a vessel adaptable for charter work. The boat's interior volume is a prominent advantage: cabins and the saloon offer roomy, highly configurable spaces, and the cockpit receives frequent praise for usability during extended cruising. The galley layout and overall ergonomics generally support life aboard and charter operations, though individual layouts and finishing levels depend on each bespoke build.

Under sail the 58 performs well in light to moderate breezes; sea trials and owner reports cite speeds around 7–8 knots when reaching. The steering is described as responsive, and for a cruising catamaran it can point reasonably well to windward. Conversely, the large superstructure and extensive glazing increase windage, so careful trim is necessary and motoring in a breeze can be more challenging.

Owner feedback is mixed in service and build consistency. Some have experienced condensation and moisture problems and HVAC/electrical quirks attributed to the expansive glazing and custom systems. There are reports of variable fit and finish — including comments that “the wiring was very sloppy” — and at least one inspection noted roughly five gallons of water entering

through the salon ceiling. After sales support and warranty handling have been described by some owners as slow or inconsistent, and repairs intended to resolve issues have, on occasion, introduced new problems. Given the bespoke nature and complexity of systems, owners recommend allowing extra time for parts, planning for additional service coordination, and budgeting for third party specialists where needed.

Pros and Cons

- Spacious, highly customizable cabins and saloon support liveaboard and charter use.
- Sails well in light-to-moderate conditions, with tests noting about 7–8 knots on a reach.
- Responsive helm with satisfactory windward ability for a cruising cat.
- Significant windage from large superstructure and glazing demands careful trim and complicates motoring in wind.
- Reports of inconsistent fit-and-finish, including sloppy wiring on some builds.
- Some owners cite moisture, HVAC/electrical quirks, and slow or inconsistent after-sales support.

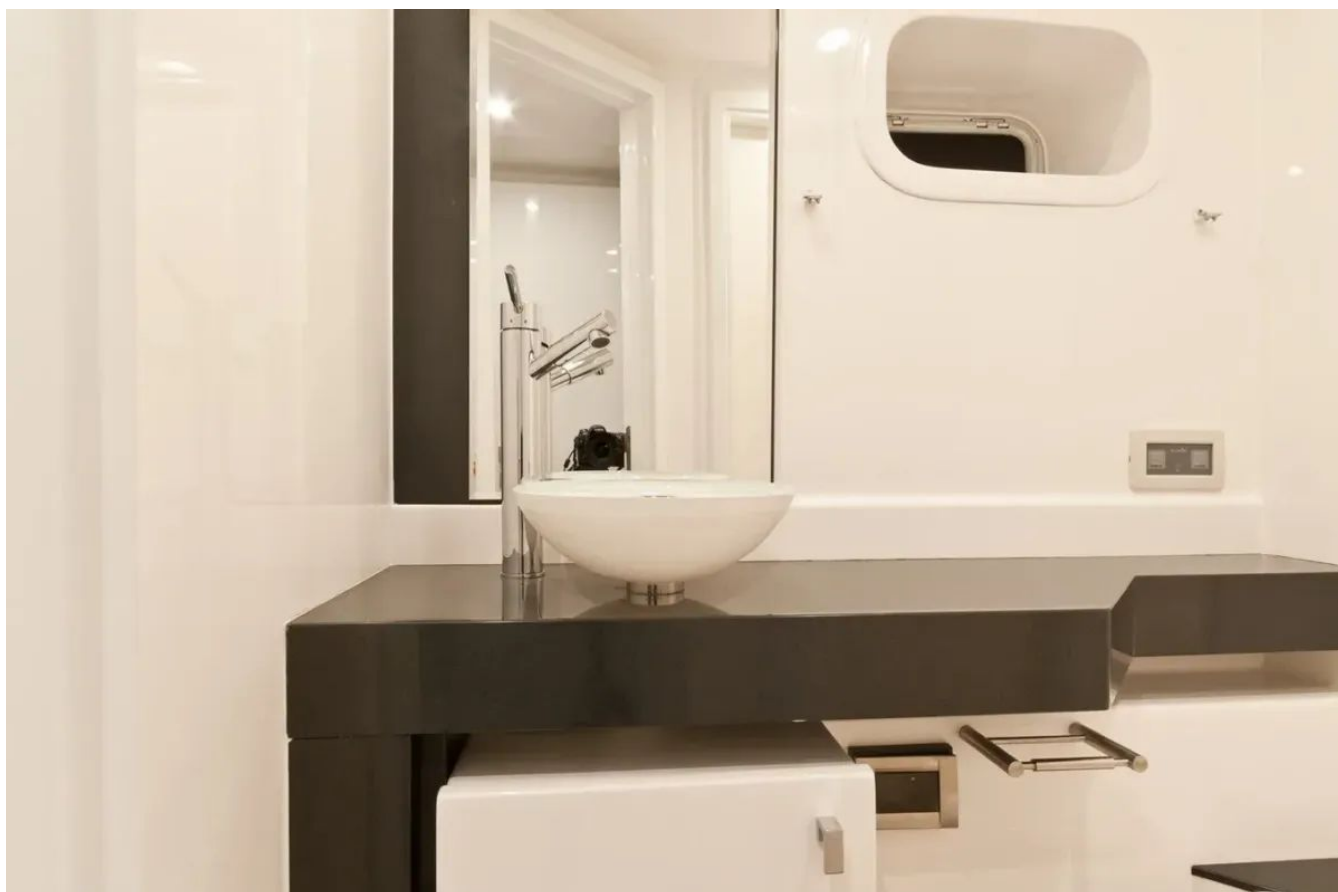
