OVERVIEW

Crafted by Sunseeker, the 34 Meter Yacht is a modern motor yacht finished on a durable fiberglass and plastic hull. Measuring 112 ft (34.14 m) overall and offering a comfortable 20 knot cruise, it combines capable performance with spacious accommodation for up to eight guests plus professional crew. Represented by Andrey Shestakov and Shestakov Yacht Sales.

Selecting a 34 Meter Yacht

Opting for the 34 Meter Yacht is a logical choice when you prioritize a mix of speed, internal volume, and a respected builder pedigree in a streamlined platform. Its monohull layout, generous 24 ft (7.32 m) beam, and twin MTU inboard diesels provide assured handling and a 30 knot top speed. Large fuel and water tanks support longer passages, while onboard arrangements are laid out for eight guests and a full crew. Features of the Model

- Performance profile: steady **cruising** at 20 knots (23.02 mph) with a 30 knot (34.52 mph) maximum achieved via twin MTU inboard diesel engines.
- Design pedigree: both hull form and interior styling are the work of Sunseeker.
- Construction: built on a monohull platform with a fiberglass and plastic hull and a deck finished in fiberglass for strength and ease of upkeep.
- Space and accommodation: configured to sleep 8 guests and fitted with 5 heads; crew facilities include 2 cabins with 4 berths to support professional operation.

- Capacity and volume: large tanks—8,000 gallons of fuel and 1,500 gallons of fresh water—back up extended cruising capability, while internal volume measures 220 GT.

- What are the performance numbers of the 34 Meter Yacht?
- With a pair of MTU inboard diesel engines, the yacht delivers a **cruising speed** of 20 knots (23.02 mph) and a **maximum speed** of 30 knots (34.52 mph).
- How many people can it accommodate?
- The vessel provides **accommodation** for 8 guests with **5 heads** , and includes **crew** quarters made up of 2 cabins and 4 berths.
- What is the hull and deck construction?
- The primary structural shell is a fiberglass and plastic monohull, while the **deck** features a fiberglass finish chosen for long term durability and straightforward maintenance.
- What are the principal dimensions and volume?
- Principal **dimensions** are LOA 112 ft (34.14 m), **beam** 24 ft (7.32 m), with a **draft** range of 24.606 to 29.528 ft (7.5–9 m). Internal volume is recorded at 220 GT.

Owner Experience Review

Owners and captains regularly report that the Sunseeker 34 Meter Yacht inspires confidence underway. Its deep V hull—around 26° of deadrise—yields a composed, level ride with minimal slamming, and the type has been handled with assurance in English Channel conditions of approximately 25 knot winds. While documented peak runs often fall around 25–26 knots, at reduced speeds the yacht returns economical consumption and range figures generally in the 1,000–1,250 nautical mile band, making it well suited to longer passages when outfitted appropriately.

Aboard, the ambiance is restrained luxury: rich American walnut joinery, expansive salon social areas, and a private forward main deck owner's suite that affords near 180° vistas. Guest accommodation comprises four en suite cabins (two doubles and two twins) with walk in lockers and abundant natural light—configurations that can comfortably carry roughly 10 guests for relaxed family cruising. The arrangement separates owner use from crew operations with dedicated forward crew quarters, and the generous flybridge can be specified with settees, a bar/BBQ, and a hot tub, creating a flexible entertaining platform ideal for private use or Mediterranean charter work.

Long term ownership reflects the scale and complexity of a true blue water motor yacht. A common propulsion fit is twin MTU 12V 2000 (M93 family) engines, which demand rigorous, heavy duty scheduled servicing. Sales and refit histories frequently cite complete engine and gearbox overhauls, substantial stabiliser (ABT TRAC) works, and shaft/propeller servicing. Expert inspections note that while primary service points are reasonably accessible, the deep set engines mean that major repairs still require notable yard time and careful budgeting for periodic systems refits.

Pros and Cons

- Deep V (~26°) hull delivers a steady, low slamming ride and has been handled confidently in ~25 knot conditions.
- Five cabin arrangement with a main deck owner suite and four en suite guest cabins accommodates both family cruising and charter operations.
- Large flybridge and deck areas can be outfitted with settees, a bar/BBQ, and a hot tub for varied entertainment layouts.
- Twin MTU 12V2000 series propulsion requires substantial scheduled maintenance and skilled service support.
- Refit records commonly include full engine and gearbox rebuilds in addition to stabiliser (ABT TRAC) and running gear overhauls.
- Engines are installed deep in the machinery spaces; although key access is acceptable, significant works still necessitate extensive yard periods and budget.

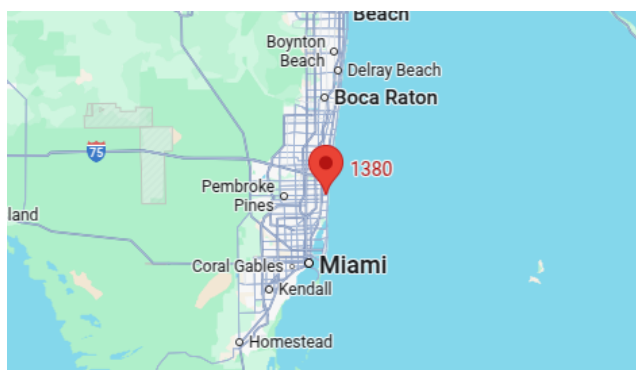
