Q: What type of yacht is the 82 Ocean? A: It is a motor yacht in the broader motor yachts category, constructed by Sunseeker on a fiberglass-and-plastic hull.

Q: How many people can the yacht accommodate? A: The arrangement supports **8 accommodations** , accompanied by **5 heads** and **2 crew cabins** to provide professional service.

Q: What are the key dimensions of the model? A: The 82 Ocean measures **LOA 82 ft (24.99 m)** , **beam 21 ft (6.55 m)** , and **max draft 19.948 ft (6.08 m)** .

Owner Experience Review

Owners often select the 82 Ocean from Sunseeker for family cruising, longer passages, charters, and lively guest entertainment, and some use it as a weekend owner-operator boat. Commentators highlight that the main-deck volume and tall glazing give the sensation of a larger yacht, while a flexible four-cabin plan with crew berths and a large, well-organized galley supports multi-guest voyages and socializing onboard. Tradeoffs noted by owners and brokers include that certain layouts, with expanded exterior or garage space, can reduce easy service access or interior storage capacity.

On the water, professional reviews describe the yacht as responsive and sporting, with immediate helm feedback and confident manners in 2–3 ft chop—summed up by one tester as “a 55 tonner that thinks it’s a raceboat.” Reported top speeds vary by engine selection and model year: earlier 82 models have logged 28–31 knots at maximum, while newer 82 Ocean Enclosed variants list a top near 25 knots. Multiple owners also point to high fuel consumption when running at speed.

From an ownership perspective, limited engine-room access is a frequent criticism, and early service reports often cite cooling-system attention and

related troubleshooting. Operating costs can be substantial—particularly for those who favor high-speed cruising—and fitting stabilizers or gyros increases service, cooling demands, and periodic major-maintenance obligations. Purchasing new brings factory warranty coverage and dealer support, but used boats may require immediate servicing or upgrades, so a thorough history review, professional survey, and commissioning checks are important.

Pros and Cons

- Pro: Main-deck volume and large glazing deliver a bigger yacht feel for the 82 Ocean.
- Pro: Flexible 4 cabin accommodations and a generously sized, well laid out galley suit family trips and entertaining.
- Pro: Sporty, responsive handling that remains firm and sure footed in 2–3 ft chop.
- Con: Heavy fuel burn at speed is a common owner complaint.
- Con: Engine room access is criticized and can complicate routine service.
- Con: Cooling system troubleshooting has appeared during trials and early operation.
