OVERVIEW

The 88 Yacht by Sunseeker is a modern motor yacht in the wider motor yachts category, constructed with a fiberglass and plastic hull and a fiberglass deck. Listed through Shestakov Yacht Sales, broker Andrey Shestakov is available to assist with configuration choices, availability status, and the purchase process.

Selecting a [88 Yacht](#)

Opting for the 88 Yacht prioritizes expansive onboard volume—88 ft (26.82 m) LOA and a 21 ft (6.48 m) beam—paired with comfortable living arrangements for up to eight guests and four bathrooms. Twin inboard MTU diesel powerplants sit behind a large 2,907-gallon diesel tank to support longer passages. As a motor yacht within the broader motor yachts segment and built on a fiberglass and plastic hull, it combines performance-oriented engineering with layouts designed for cruising comfort.

Q: What is the exact size of the 88 Yacht? A: The **LOA** measures 88 ft (26.82 m), the **beam** is 21 ft (6.48 m), and the **max draft** is 22.966 ft (7 m).

Q: How is the yacht powered? A: Propulsion is provided by **2 MTU inboard diesel** engines, consistent with its classification as a motor yacht in the motor

yachts sector.

Q: What are the accommodations like? A: The layout supports **accommodations** for up to 8 guests and includes **4 heads**, designed to balance guest privacy with onboard comfort.

Q: What materials are used for the hull and deck? A: The **hull** falls in the fiberglass and plastic category, while the **deck** is constructed from fiberglass.

Owner Experience Review

Owners tend to choose the 88 Yacht for family-focused cruising—comfortably hosting up to eight guests with arrangements that can include a four person crew—and many operate her privately as an owner operator or retain a small professional crew. The generous layout and substantial outdoor spaces, notably the flybridge and Beach Club, make the yacht well suited to weekend entertaining, and brokers frequently market the four cabin, crew capable configuration as charter friendly. On passage, owners and reviewers describe the helm as "genuinely enjoyable to steer," noting a composed, well mannered feel; typical cruise speeds are reported around 20–24 knots with top speeds in the 27–28 knot range depending on the engine package selected.

Guest comfort centers on all accommodation located on the lower deck, featuring a full beam amidships owner's stateroom complete with a lounge and dressing area. The Beach Club—often fitted with the X TEND sunbed—is commonly highlighted for its adaptability as a waterside living area and for

storing toys, while the forward galley beneath the lower helm windscreen is praised for storage capacity but can feel removed from main social zones and may not suit every owner's preferences. Maintenance observations are mixed: MTU M94/M96/M96X packages (roughly 2,000 hp options) are prevalent and carry standard MTU servicing expectations, yet some owners note that access for routine work can require removing interior panels or fixtures; there are also reports across certain Sunseeker models of joystick-related issues where the bow thruster may cut out after about 40 seconds.

Pros and Cons

- Steering feel is often praised as enjoyable, with handling that remains composed for a yacht of this size.
- The Beach Club with X TEND sunbed provides flexible waterside living space and useful toy stowage.
- Versatile ownership options: ideal for family cruising, can be owner operated or crewed, and is commonly offered as a charter ready four cabin layout.
- The forward galley sits apart from main social areas, which may not suit owners who prefer open entertaining spaces.
- Some maintenance tasks may require removing interior components to gain service access.
- A minority of owners report joystick control problems on certain Sunseeker platforms, including instances where the bow thruster disengages after roughly 40 seconds.
