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OVERVIEW

The 95 Yacht from Sunseeker is a sophisticated motor yacht constructed on a sturdy fiberglass and plastic hull with a GRP deck. Marketed globally by Andrey Shestakov and the team at Shestakov Yacht Sales, it blends a confident 24 knot cruise with a 26 knot top end, twin MTU inboard diesel propulsion, and interior arrangements suited for longer stays onboard.

Selecting a 95 Yacht

Opting for the 95 Yacht places emphasis on a blend of capable performance, imposing dimensions that translate to generous internal volume, and proven twin engine reliability. Built as a contemporary motor yacht on a fiberglass and plastic platform, it provides a flexible layout for private cruising or entertaining guests, backed by a 95 ft LOA and a 21 ft beam for comfortable living spaces.

Features of the Model

- Performance-oriented: comfortable cruise at 24 kn with a top speed of 26 kn, equivalent to 27.62 mph and 29.92 mph respectively.
- Propulsion by twin MTU inboard diesel installations for dependable and responsive power.
- Robust fiberglass and plastic hull paired with a GRP deck to support long-term ownership.
- Generous onboard volume: 98 GT gross tonnage, sleeping capacity for 10 guests, plus 2 dedicated crew cabins.

- Q: What type of yacht is the 95 Yacht? A: The 95 Yacht is a motor yacht built on a fiberglass and plastic hull and finished with a **GRP** deck, engineered for efficient and comfortable cruising.
- Q: How fast does it go? A: Typical performance expectations are a **cruise**

speed of 24 kn (27.62 mph) with a **maximum speed** near 26 kn (29.92 mph), depending on load and sea conditions.

• Q: What powers the yacht? A: The yacht is driven by **twin MTU inboard diesel** engines, offering reliable propulsion and responsive handling characteristics.

• Q: How spacious is it on board? A: Measuring **95 ft (28.98 m)** overall with a **21 ft (6.55 m)** beam and **98 GT** gross tonnage, it accommodates up to 10 guests and includes **2 crew cabins** .

Owner Experience Review

Owners and captains operating the 95 Yacht from Sunseeker typically use it for family getaways and hosting, appreciating the expansive saloon, several dining venues, and the highly regarded main deck master arranged as a triplex (main deck stateroom, separate dressing area and marble bathroom below). The interior frequently reads more like a well appointed apartment than a conventional yacht, making it ideal for weekend escapes and longer voyages. While single handing is possible, many owners prefer using it as a crewed or charter capable raised pilothouse yacht because of its size, onboard systems, and dedicated crew quarters.

When underway, reviewers describe the 95 Yacht as composed and steady with an unexpectedly tight turning circle. Its sea keeping compares favorably to mini superyacht peers, with trials showing cruising speeds around 20–24 knots and top ends in the mid 20s. One owner/observer summed up the helm experience: “I have never driven anything quite like it,” capturing the unusual engagement for a yacht of this scale.

Everyday functionality is generally strong, aided by an engine room laid out with flat mounted engines, outboard gensets and clear service access. However, walk through reports and forum discussions highlight some trade offs: the galley can feel like a service dead end; access to guest cabins depends on relatively narrow, steep stairs that may be difficult for less mobile guests; and steps between living zones and machinery spaces can complicate routine inspections. As with many large builds, new deliveries often have substantial snag lists, so anticipate active after sales and warranty follow up. Standard propulsion is MTU 12V 2000 (with Caterpillar C32 offered as an option), so owners should plan for major engine maintenance schedules and specialist servicing.

Pros and Cons

- Main deck master triplex provides exceptional owner volume and finish, ideal for family cruising.
- Composed handling, tight turning ability and robust sea keeping inspire confidence underway.
- Engine room well arranged with flat mounted engines and outboard gensets enhances serviceability.
- Galley arrangement can act as a dead end, disrupting crew and service circulation.
- Narrow, steep staircases to guest quarters and machinery areas can be challenging for less mobile guests and routine access.
- Early ownership may require extensive snagging attention and frequent after sales or warranty interventions.
