Selecting a SUNSEEKER 90

For buyers seeking a blend of robust performance and ample living space, the SUNSEEKER 90 is a compelling choice. Measuring 90 ft (27.71 m) overall with a 20 ft (6.3 m) beam, it delivers both roominess and pace: a typical cruise of 23 kn (26.47 mph) and a top end near 28 kn (32.22 mph) driven by twin CAT powerplants. Large fuel tanks (2,245.46 gal) and a 396.26 gal water supply let owners remain aboard for extended passages, reinforcing its credentials as a premium motor yacht in the cruising sector.

- Twin CAT engines for dependable propulsion and power delivery

Q: What is the cruising and top speed of the SUNSEEKER 90? A: The vessel achieves a **cruising speed** around 23 kn (26.47 mph) and reaches a **maximum speed** of approximately 28 kn (32.22 mph), offering reassuring performance for a high end motor yacht in the cruising category.

Q: What engines power the yacht? A: The SUNSEEKER 90 is equipped with **2 x CAT** engines, supplying strong and reliable propulsion.

Owner Experience Review

Owners and brokers highlight the SUNSEEKER 90 for its flexibility: it suits multigenerational family cruising, lively anchored entertaining, and in many cases private or commercial charter—brokers note it holds strong market appeal and some earlier units carry commercial coding. Some proprietors run with a compact crew, while others find it manageable for a seasoned owner operator.

On the water, operators report a reassuringly stable ride for a yacht of this size and often describe its handling as “very nearly as agile and sea kindly as some of its sportier siblings.” The typical cruising feel centers on about 23 knots, though owners should be mindful of fuel consumption; one earlier listing suggested approximately 500 L/h at that cruise speed, illustrating the operating costs at planing speeds.

The beach club configuration routinely earns praise as a standout amenity. Owners call the X TEND™ beach club transformative for watersports and

sea level relaxation—children are drawn to it and launching toys is straightforward. Internally, the expansive salon, full beam master suite and multiple guest cabins are commonly noted as genuinely comfortable for long stays aboard. Up top, the flybridge and enlarged exterior entertaining areas receive favorable comments for sunbathing and hosting, with reviewers appreciating the extra beam and internal volume compared with older 90 foot competitors.

Practical ownership considerations tend to focus on access and maintenance planning. On some early examples captains have reported tight crew quarters and limited engine room access, including awkward generator servicing. Across model years, many boats carry large power packages (for example, Caterpillar C32 on earlier builds or MAN V12 setups on later ones), so scheduled heavyweight engine maintenance is part of ongoing ownership. Brokerage records frequently show periodic refits and modernisation projects—important items to budget for when evaluating a pre owned SUNSEEKER 90.

Pros and Cons

- Stable, confidence inspiring ride for a yacht of this size, with handling often described as agile and sea kindly.
- XTEND™ beach club and straightforward water access make entertaining and watersports effortless.
- Generous salon, full beam master suite, and ample flybridge space are well suited to family cruising and socialising.
- Fuel consumption at a typical 23 knot cruise is substantial; an earlier example reported roughly 500 L/h at that speed.
- Some earlier builds exhibit cramped crew accommodations and confined engine room/generator access.
- Pre owned listings commonly show refits and upgrades; plan for periodic

systems modernisation and heavy engine service.

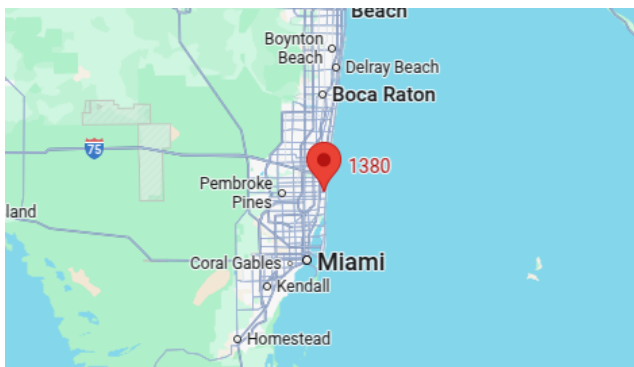
