## OVERVIEW

---

The 55 from TAYANA is a capable bluewater platform offered as a sail yacht in a traditional sloop arrangement. Its hull is constructed of fiberglass and plastic with a fiberglass deck, and propulsion is provided by a single Yanmar inboard diesel for uncomplicated, dependable motoring. Shestakov Yacht Sales represents the model worldwide, with broker Andrey Shestakov handling inquiries for interested buyers.

## Selecting a 55

---

Opting for the 55 is logical if you prioritize a tried-and-tested sail yacht that pairs single-engine simplicity with the sail-handling ease of a sloop. At 55 ft LOA and a 16 ft beam it delivers roomy accommodations and generous storage, while the significant draft range provides stability and performance in deeper water. The three-head arrangement makes it suitable for family voyages or entertaining guests. ## Questions and Answers

---

Q: What type of yacht is the 55 by TAYANA? A: It is a sail yacht arranged as a sloop with a fiberglass and plastic hull.

Q: What are the key dimensions of the model? A: The 55 measures **LOA 55 ft (16.92 m)** with a **beam of 16 ft (4.9 m)**, offering substantial interior volume and deck area.

Q: What is the draft range? A: The **draft** covers roughly **18.045–32.808 ft (5.5–10 m)** , providing deep water stability where depths allow.

Q: What propulsion does it use? A: A single **Yanmar inboard diesel** engine serves as the vessel's propulsion system, favoring simplicity and ease of maintenance.

## Owner Experience Review

---

Owners commonly select the TAYANA 55 for serious offshore work and long-distance cruising; multiple owners report circumnavigations and passages exceeding 12,000 miles. One owner summarized their experience after extensive cruising, noting they and their spouse covered more than 12,000 miles in three years and typically sailed without additional crew. The boat's heavy displacement hull is consistently praised as sea kindly and substantial, tracking well and delivering predictable motion on long passages, with comfortable passage speeds most often in the mid 6 to low 8 knot band depending on wind and loading. While manageable short handed, handling in heavy weather rewards experienced crew.

As a liveaboard and long-cruise platform, the TAYANA 55 is lauded for its center cockpit arrangement, large private aft owner's cabin, classic teak joinery, and a capacious salon. Many extant examples show their age, prompting owners to undertake refits covering engines and mechanical systems, electrical and plumbing upgrades, and cosmetic renewals. Budgeting for upkeep is a recurring point: standing rigging, new sails, and chainplate work are among the higher cost items on older boats, with some owners noting chainplate parts around \$1.6K; broker listings frequently highlight the

need for substantial systems refurbishment. Families also appreciate the model for roomy coastal cruising and weekend use, though its offshore-oriented, heavier design sets realistic expectations for handling and cruising speeds.

## Pros and Cons

- Proven bluewater pedigree with owner reports of extended ocean passages and full circumnavigations.
- Sea-kindly, heavy-displacement behavior that tracks straight and remains predictable on extended legs.
- Liveaboard-oriented center-cockpit layout featuring a spacious aft owner's cabin and extensive teak interiors.
- Moderate passage speeds, commonly in the mid-6 to low-8 knot range.
- Heavy-weather sail handling benefits from experience, particularly when sailing short-handed.
- Older yachts frequently require significant refits—rigging, chainplates, sails, and major systems are typical high-cost items.

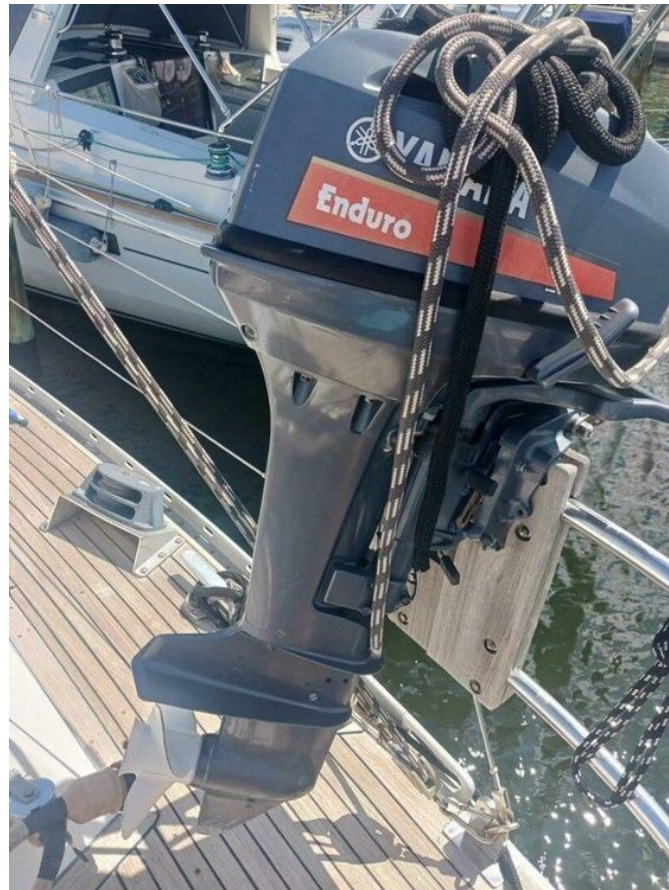
