OVERVIEW

The 3200 Open by Tiara is a flexible sport cruiser in the wider category of motor yachts. It is driven by twin Cummins inboard diesel engines and measures 33 ft (10.06 m) overall with a 13 ft (3.96 m) beam. Typical cruise speed is 22.59 kn (26 mph) with a top end near 27.81 kn (32 mph). Selecting a 3200 Open

Consider the 3200 Open when you want the dependability of twin Cummins inboard diesels, manageable hull dimensions for maneuvering and marina comfort, and the flexibility to accommodate up to 10 people with a single head. Positioned as a practical motor yacht in the motor yachts field, it strikes a balance between steady performance (22.59 kn cruise / 27.81 kn max) and tankage suitable for day outings or weekend escapes.

Q: What kind of **engines** power the 3200 Open? A: It is fitted with 2 Cummins **inboard diesel** engines, providing dependable power and fuel economy.

Q: What are the **cruise speed** and **top speed** ? A: The vessel typically cruises at about 22.59 kn (26 mph) and can reach approximately 27.81 kn (32 mph) at full throttle.

Q: How many **accommodations** and how many **heads** are on board? A: The interior layout sleeps up to 10 people and includes one onboard **head** (1).

Q: What are the key **dimensions** and **draft** ? A: Overall length is 33 ft (10.06 m), beam measures 13 ft (3.96 m), and maximum **draft** is 9.843 ft (3 m).

Owner Experience Review

Owners commonly characterize the Tiara 3200 Open as a true multipurpose craft. It transitions smoothly between family-oriented cruising and dedicated fishing use, offering cockpit layouts and seating arrangements that simplify day trips and social gatherings. For weekend stays, the forward queen pedestal berth combined with a convertible dinette makes overnighting practical, and many listings mention optional bait-prep stations or wet bars that appeal to anglers and hosts alike.

On the water the hull inspires confidence, running level and getting up on plane without hesitation. One owner report lists cruising at roughly 3300 RPM for about 27 mph while consuming close to 30 gph combined. Engine selection affects both the vessel's character and range: Crusader 8.1 gas installations are noted for their liveliness, Cummins QSB diesel setups are popular for extended range, and some owners feel Volvo D6-310 packages lack sufficient power for this hull.

Interior appointments are utilitarian and durable, featuring Corian counters and a two-burner electric cooktop, although the under-counter refrigerator is often described as undersized for long voyages (many owners recommend adding an optional cockpit refrigerator). Maintenance feedback from owners and listings highlights periodic riser and manifold work and vigilance on heat exchangers/aftercoolers. The powered, push-button helm-deck hatch improves engine-room access, but certain service tasks—such as working on

front-side plugs or shaft and coupling components—can be cramped, and major repairs may necessitate removing the heavy hatch.

Pros and Cons

- Versatile platform that comfortably shifts between family cruising, day boating, and fishing.
- Confident, stable handling with quick planing and an owner-reported 27 mph at 3300 RPM burning about 30 gph total.
- Forward queen-size pedestal berth and practical cockpit/helm ergonomics support overnighting and active use.
- Under-counter refrigerator is small for extended cruising.
- Some owners consider Volvo D6-310 setups underpowered for this hull.
- Routine ownership includes riser/manifold and heat-exchanger/aftercooler service, and certain jobs are tight despite the powered hatch.
