OVERVIEW

The 48 Convertible from Tiara marries purpose-built sportfishing capability with comfortable cruising amenities. Listed as a motor yacht and tailored to the needs of a sport fisherman, it rides on a sturdy fiberglass and plastic hull. If your priorities include both offshore fishing and comfortable family cruising, the 48 Convertible is worth serious consideration. Its twin Caterpillar inboard diesels, substantial fuel reserves, and dual heads make it suitable for extended passages and liveaboard convenience. As a motor yacht with clear sport fisherman intent, the design emphasizes reliable systems and approachable maintenance routines for owners and crews.

Owner Experience Review

Owners are drawn to the 48 Convertible from Tiara for its versatility as an offshore sportfisher and a comfortable cruiser for family getaways and weekend escapes. The expansive, fish-oriented cockpit makes tournament days manageable, while the three stateroom/two head arrangement, spacious salon, and well-appointed galley accommodate longer cruises with ease. Many owners praise the flybridge for its intuitive helm layout and clear sightlines, and note how simply the cockpit converts from fishing mode to a social entertaining space.

Underway, owners commonly report a solid, comfortable ride for a 48' convertible, with steady cruising characteristics and reassuring handling in following seas. With standard Caterpillar C18 installations, the platform provides strong mid range performance, and several boats are equipped with joystick controls for easier docking and close-quarters maneuvering. Some owners observe that handling tends to feel a bit heavier than ultra light tournament convertibles — a compromise that prioritizes comfort and seakeeping over razor sharp responsiveness.

Maintenance for the class is typical: C18 diesels follow regular service intervals and associated costs, and owners often discuss accessibility for items like sensors and engine room components in community forums. Pre-owned

listings frequently note recent upgrades to generators, electronics, or upholstery, so prospective buyers should factor in potential systems refreshes on older vessels. Many owners also cite responsive factory support from Tiara when researching build details or resolving technical issues.

Pros and Cons

- Seakindly, comfortable ride with stable cruising and composed behavior in following seas.
- Three stateroom/two head layout, roomy salon, and generous storage make it well suited for family cruising and island hopping.
- Fish friendly cockpit and an ergonomic flybridge create a capable platform for both tournament fishing and entertaining guests.
- Handling can feel heavier compared with razor sharp, purpose built tournament convertibles, reflecting a design emphasis on comfort.
- Older vessels commonly require updates to generators, electronics, or soft goods, so buyers should budget for potential refits.
- Routine diesel maintenance on Caterpillar C18s and some service access tasks (for example, sensors) require time and expense typical for this category.

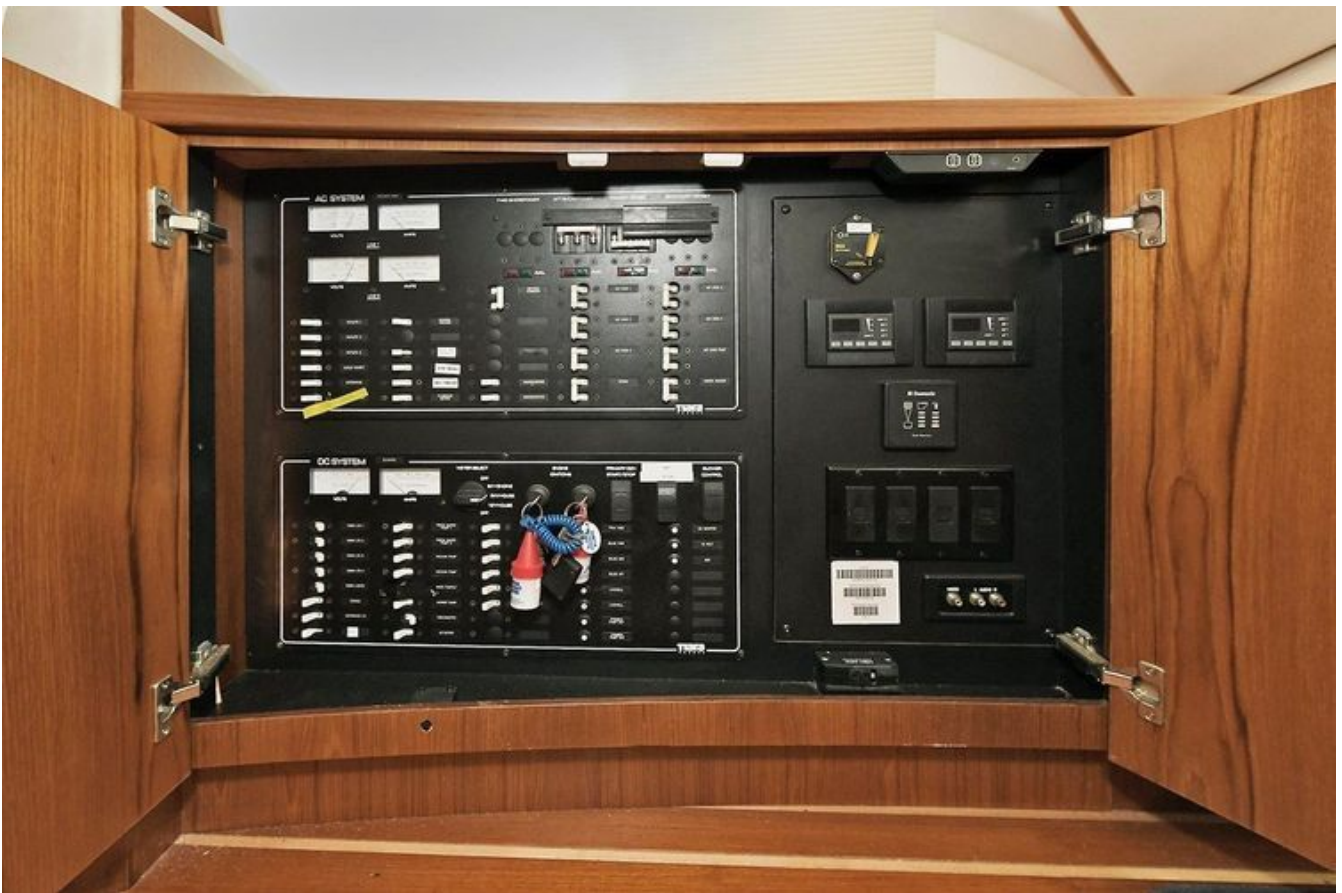

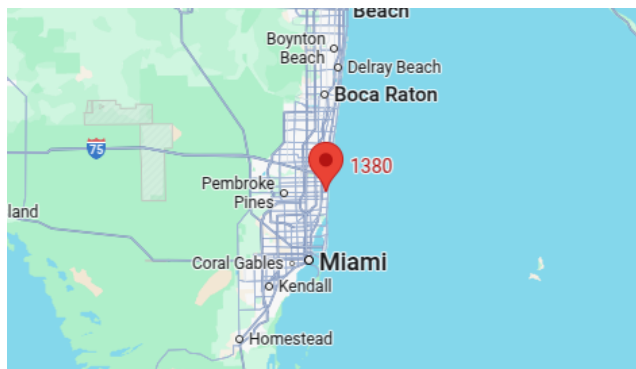
