OVERVIEW

The 48 LE from Tiara merges spirited performance with refined comfort in a versatile motor yacht that also functions exceptionally well as a premium cruiser. Built on a robust fiberglass and plastic foundation with a Semi-Displacement hull form, this model is offered through Shestakov Yacht Sales with brokerage by Andrey Shestakov.

Selecting a 48 LE

Opt for the 48 LE when you want a 48 ft (14.73 m) hull that marries efficient cruising with the ability to run fast while delivering comfortable living spaces. Its Triple Mercury diesel propulsion and Semi-Displacement hull help achieve a practical cruising pace of 20 knots (with a top capability near 30 knots), making it well suited for coastal runs and extended weekend getaways. The layout supports 4 guests, includes two heads, and provides a dedicated crew cabin, positioning this motor yacht as a thoughtful cruiser option for owners who appreciate the design heritage of Tiara.

- Hull and deck: Semi-Displacement running surface with a hull category of fiberglass and plastic and a molded Fiberglass deck
- Design pedigree: Hull engineered by the Tiara Yachts Engineering Team; cabin and living spaces styled by the Tiara Yachts Design Team
- Performance: Typical cruise at 20 kn (23.02 mph); top attainable speed approximately 30 kn (34.52 mph)
- Power: Three Mercury diesel engines configured for solid handling and redundancy

Questions and Answers

- Q: What is the overall type of the 48 LE? A: It's a versatile motor yacht marketed as an upscale cruiser built on a fiberglass and plastic hull with a Semi-Displacement profile, designed to strike a balance between operational efficiency and onboard comfort. Key focus: **type** and **hull** .
- Q: What **engines** power the yacht? A: This model is fitted with 3 x Mercury **diesel** engines, supplying dependable propulsion and system redundancy.
- Q: What is the **speed** profile? A: Expect a typical **cruise** speed of 20 knots (23.02 mph) and an advertised **max** speed near 30 knots (34.52 mph).
- Q: What is the **draft** range? A: The draft spans from 7.928 ft (2.4166 m) at its shallowest to 12.576 ft (3.8333 m) at its deepest.
- Q: How are the **accommodations** arranged? A: The layout sleeps **4** , includes **2 heads** , and provides crew facilities: a single crew cabin with **2 berths**.

Owner Experience Review

Owners are drawn to the 48 LE from Tiara for its practical versatility: the pair of staterooms with private heads comfortably supports family or extended cruising, while the enclosed salon, expansive cockpit, and power-rotating lounge create an inviting environment for weekend socializing. Adding the Adventure Module and a reconfigurable cockpit allows the platform to shift toward sport-day activities or serious fishing without feeling compromised.

When underway the craft delivers a composed, stable ride for an express-style yacht of this size, with reviewers citing Tiara's traditionally robust hull construction. Independent testing recorded a steady cruise near 36.7 knots at roughly 5,000 rpm, and one test noted that even around 47 knots—just under the claimed 49-knot top end—the 48 LE feels planted and controlled as if moving at much lower speed. The helm arrangement, featuring Garmin OneHelm integration and well-cushioned seating, earns consistent praise for ease of use and reducing operator fatigue.

From an ownership perspective, the triple Mercury Verado outboard package (configured around triple 600 Verado V12s) eliminates the need for extensive inboard machinery spaces, though these high-performance engines are notable for higher maintenance costs. As a relatively new design with testing commencing around 2024, long-term reliability statistics remain limited; Tiara highlights its dealer and service network, and provides documented owner manuals, warranty coverage, and service transfer procedures to bolster owner confidence.

Pros and Cons

- Flexible cockpit with a power-rotating lounge improves social flow and sightlines for day boating.
- Predictable, composed ride quality with a comfortable cruise observed around 36.7 knots.
- Two staterooms and two private heads enable authentic multi-day family cruising.
- Triple Mercury Verado V12 outboards represent high-cost service items.
- As a recent entry to the market, long-term owner reliability data is still limited.
- Independent testing logged roughly 47 knots, slightly below the manufacturer's claimed 49-knot top speed.
