Selecting a 48 LS

If an agile 48-foot platform with a 14-foot beam that marries pace, onboard comfort, and uncomplicated operation is what you're after, consider the 48 LS. Powered by triple Mercury outboards, it posts a 33-knot cruising speed and can push to a 50-knot top end, while a single-head layout keeps things practical for day outings and short overnights. With 660 gallons of fuel and 100 gallons of freshwater aboard, it supports longer hops between marinas. Crafted by Tiara, the design reflects high-end finishes and intentional ergonomics for each voyage.

Features of the Model

- Performance assurance from three Mercury outboards using Gas fuel, delivering a comfortable 33-kn cruise and a 50-kn top speed for efficient passages.
- Proportions that balance capacity and handling: 48 ft LOA, 14 ft beam, and a draft spanning 7.928–12.576 ft to suit differing conditions.
- Solid build with a fiberglass and plastic hull and a Fiberglass deck for longevity and minimal upkeep.
- Practical dayboat amenities including a single head and expansive deck areas designed for socializing.
- Marketed as a motor yacht optimized for pleasurable cruising.

Questions and Answers

Q: What type of yacht is the 48 LS? A: It is a motor yacht designed for comfortable cruising and built on a resilient fiberglass and plastic hull.

Q: How fast does it go? A: The 48 LS maintains a **cruising speed** of 33 knots (37.98 mph) and can attain a **maximum speed** of 50 knots (57.54 mph) when fitted with triple Mercury outboards.

Q: What are the key dimensions and draft? A: **LOA** measures 48 ft (14.73 m), **beam** is 14 ft (4.32 m), and **draft** varies between 7.928 ft (2.4166 m) and 12.576 ft (3.8333 m).

Q: What capacities and amenities support day cruising? A: **Fuel capacity** totals 660 gal and **water capacity** is 100 gal; there is 1 **head** , and the deck is finished in Fiberglass for straightforward maintenance.

Owner Experience Review

Owners are drawn to the 48 LS from Tiara for its split personality: it performs as a rapid, sporty day yacht while also serving as a practical family weekender. Belowdecks, private spaces include a bow island queen, a mid-cabin with convertible berths, and a stand-up head with a separate shower, comfortably sleeping four. Above, the social arrangement steals the show—continuous gathering areas, a U-shaped mid-cockpit galley, a rotating lounge, generous bow seating with powered footrests, and a hullside terrace that opens onto a large swim platform. Reviewers note quality fit-and-finish, with teak accents and refined joinery throughout.

On the water, the triple 600-hp Verado V12s propel the boat briskly, with reported top speeds in the 50–60 mph range and a normal cruise around 33–35 knots; expect significant fuel consumption at those speeds. Despite the performance, many trials praise a smooth, yacht-like ride and a helm that feels remarkably calm. Handling is predictable—Tiara refined the hull and systems around steerable Verado lower units to achieve composed manners.

Maintenance reflects the complexity of the V12 package: owners and forum

posts have documented initial teething problems and sensor/PCM service bulletins or recalls. Parts and service for the V12s are more expensive than for smaller outboards, although routine access for checks is well-considered under the engine hatch. For buyers prioritizing high performance, upscale finishes, and entertaining versatility, the 48 LS rewards—but plan for higher fuel use and V12-level maintenance costs.

Pros and Cons

- Yacht-like ride with a notably quiet helm when cruising.
- Versatile social layout featuring a deck galley, rotating lounge, bow seating, and a hullside terrace.
- Private sleeping for four with premium materials and finish.
- Substantial fuel consumption at typical cruise speeds.
- Early technical issues reported with V12 Verado sensors and PCM.
- Greater service complexity and cost compared with smaller outboards.
