The C53 Coupe from Tiara is a contemporary motor yacht in the broader motor yachts category, set on a proven fiberglass and plastic hull. Offered by Shestakov Yacht Sales, it combines assured performance with comfortable onboard living. If your priority is a well-rounded cruiser that blends performance with everyday comforts, the C53 Coupe is a compelling option. Measuring 54 ft (16.61 m) LOA with a 15 ft (4.85 m) beam, it provides proportions suited to weekend trips and longer coastal passages. Twin inboard Volvo diesels deliver a typical cruise of 26 kn (29.92 mph) and a top end around 33 kn (37.98 mph) when you need more speed. Practical systems—650 gal fuel, 150 gal water, and two heads—underscore its usability for real-world cruising. Q: What type of yacht is the C53 Coupe? A: It's a motor yacht in the motor yachts segment, built on a durable fiberglass and plastic hull designed for **reliability** and **low maintenance** .

Q: What performance can I expect? A: Plan on a typical **cruise speed** of 26 kn (29.92 mph) with a **maximum speed** capability up to 33 kn (37.98 mph) to provide flexible passage-making options.

Q: What powers the yacht? A: Propulsion comes from **2 x Volvo inboard diesel** engines, offering a mix of fuel efficiency and familiar serviceability.

Owner Experience Review

Owners and reviewers frequently describe the C53 Coupe from Tiara as a versatile platform well suited to family weekends, coastal hops, and entertaining guests. Independent trials recorded a 34-knot top speed and noted consistent fuel consumption from 1500 rpm up through WOT; handling impressions include comments that it "handles like a 25-foot sport boat instead of a 53-foot luxury cruiser." Equipped with Volvo IPS, joystick control, and DPS plus excellent 360° sight lines, the boat makes single-handed docking achievable and can even maneuver sideways for tight slips.

Inside, the bright salon with expansive windows flows directly to a 15'-wide cockpit that functions as an extension of the living space—perfect for outdoor-focused days, charter-style entertaining, or occasional sport fishing. Down below, owners can choose between a two-stateroom layout featuring a full-beam midship master and forward VIP, or an optional three-stateroom arrangement; the galley is sized for two and well appointed, and reviewers

have praised the master as "one of the brightest" available. Tradeoffs reported by owners include limited overhead clearance in the engine room accessed by a hatch and short ladder, main electrical panels located under a salon seat requiring cushion removal to access, and forum discussions about IPS-related pod/transmission failures, water-in-oil events, and electronic faults that can carry significant repair costs. Additionally, the optional Seakeeper 9 occupies notable engine-room space and was listed near \$116,045 on a tested specification.

Pros and Cons

- IPS joystick and DPS paired with 360° visibility enable single-handed docking and highly precise close-quarters maneuvering.
- The bright salon with large windows opens to a 15'-wide cockpit that serves as a substantial outdoor living area for entertaining.
- Configurable accommodations, including a full-beam midship master and an optional three-stateroom layout, suit family cruising and weekenders.
- Engine room access is via a hatch and short ladder with limited overhead clearance, making routine maintenance awkward.
- Owner and forum reports on Volvo Penta IPS reference pod/transmission failures, water-in-oil incidents, and electronic faults, with potentially costly repairs.
- Main electrical panels positioned beneath salon seating are inconvenient to access, and the optional Seakeeper 9 consumes engine-room real estate and added expense (approximately \$116,045).
