Questions and Answers

Q: What type of yacht is the 7m? A: It is a compact sailing yacht conceived as an elegant daysailer with a fiberglass and plastic hull. This clear **type** focus makes day sailing straightforward.

Q: What engine powers the boat? A: The yacht is fitted with 1 x **Yanmar Inboard Diesel** engine, paired with a 7 gal fuel tank to ensure dependable maneuvering.

Q: What is the draft and keel configuration? A: Maximum **draft** is 7.928 ft (2.4166 m), and the hull employs a **centerboard** arrangement to give confidence when operating in varied depths.

Q: What are the principal dimensions? A: **LOA** is 23 ft (7.01 m) and **beam** is 7 ft (2.18 m), offering compact proportions that aid easy handling and mooring.

Owner Experience Review

Owners of the 7m from TOFINOU commonly use it for leisurely family day sails and short coastal weekends; its trailerable and beachable nature widens launch possibilities. The lifting centreplate trims the draft to roughly 0.5 m, allowing the boat to sit comfortably on a beach or mudflat without fuss. The roomy, sociable cockpit is ideal for picnics and light harbour fishing, and although below-deck accommodation is limited, many owners note that sleeping on the sole boards beside the centreplate case is workable for occasional overnights.

Under sail the design's lively hull and lifting keel deliver responsive, intuitive behavior. Sea trials describe the boat as thoroughly gentlemanly in 15–22 knot gusty conditions, tracking upwind at a steady 4.5–5 knots when properly sailed, with a light helm feel and minimal spray. It is not built to point extremely high, so pinching is unproductive, but when sailed freely it rewards with comfortable speed. The shallow-water performance is a highlight—navigating creeks, drying out, and competing in classic yacht regattas are all viable, and some owners even race in events such as Les Voiles de St Tropez.

Ownership emphasizes aesthetics and uncomplicated enjoyment, balanced

with sensible maintenance. The brightwork—teak decks and varnished mahogany coamings—attracts praise but demands regular care to remain immaculate. Routine inspection of the lifting/centreplate mechanism (pivot pins, bushings, winches) is recommended, and the compact inboard area beneath the aft locker stays accessible via the lockers. One long-term owner recounted an expensive and ultimately unsuccessful electric-drive conversion (about £21,000) complicated by a damp engine bay, reinforcing that traditional diesel propulsion can be the more reliable option. Multiple owners still refer to their boats as the “apple of my eye,” highlighting a low stress way to enjoy time on the water.

Pros and Cons

- Precise, intuitive handling with a lively hull and light helm.
- Lifting centreplate allows shallow water access, beaching, and easy drying out (~0.5 m draft).
- Large, sociable cockpit well suited to day sailing, picnics, and entertaining.
- Minimal cabin accommodation; best for day use or very short overnights.
- Brightwork (teak and varnished mahogany) needs regular upkeep to stay pristine.
- Not a high pointing design; it sails best when not pinched too close to the wind.

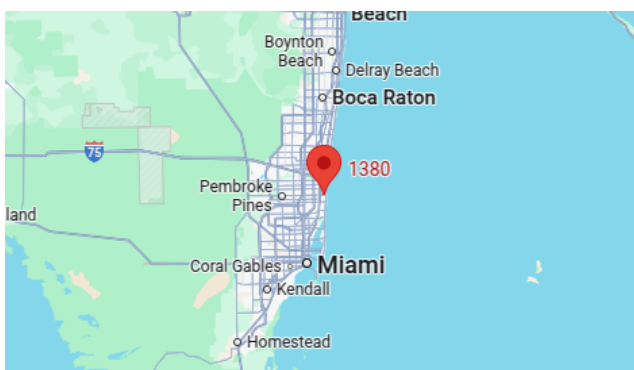
