OVERVIEW

The 51 Fly from TOY MARINE is a motor yacht engineered for assured coastal passages, marrying the livability of a cruiser with purposeful performance. Built with fiberglass and plastic construction and a Deep Vee hull form driven by twin Volvo inboard diesels, it delivers a steady 26-knot cruise and a top end near 33 knots. Offered by Andrey Shestakov and the Shestakov Yacht Sales team.

Selecting a 51 Fly

For buyers seeking a well-proportioned coastal cruiser that's easy to handle, the 51 Fly is a compelling option. Measuring 51 ft LOA (15.72 m) with a 15 ft beam (4.85 m) and a 9.569 ft (2.9166 m) draft, it provides useful internal volume for guests and crew while remaining owner-operator friendly. Configured with two heads and a dedicated crew cabin, the layout supports extended weekends and coastal itineraries where comfort, pace, and operational simplicity are priorities.

Features of the Model

- Performance profile: A 26-knot cruising speed and a 33-knot top speed enable brisk passages and flexible scheduling.
- Powertrain: Twin Volvo inboard diesel engines deliver dependable propulsion with straightforward maintenance expectations.
- Construction: Deep Vee hull constructed in fiberglass and plastic with a fiberglass deck for durability and low upkeep.
- Living and operations: Two heads plus one crew cabin create separation between guest spaces and crew operations for longer trips.
- Capacities tuned for range and comfort: 581 gal fuel capacity and 132 gal

freshwater capacity support extended coastal cruising.

Questions and Answers

Q: What type of yacht is the 51 Fly? A: It is a motor yacht designed for

comfortable cruising, marketed as a capable cruiser built on a fiberglass and plastic hull with a Deep Vee hull form.

Q: What are the key performance figures? A: The 51 Fly achieves a **cruise speed** of 26 knots (29.92 mph) and a **max speed** of 33 knots (37.98 mph), enabling efficient point to point passages.

Q: Which engines power the yacht? A: Propulsion is provided by **2 x Volvo inboard diesel** engines, offering reliable and economical power delivery.

Q: What capacities support longer trips? A: The yacht carries **581 gallons of fuel** and **132 gallons of fresh water**, and includes **2 heads** plus **1 crew cabin** to increase autonomy and comfort while under way.

Owner Experience Review

Owners and captains who select the 51 Fly from TOY MARINE commonly use it for family cruising, weekend escapes, and assured coastal runs. Its boutique, low volume construction appeals to private owners, and the approximate 350 nm range when cruising in the high 20s knots makes it ideal for coastal passagemaking more than transoceanic blue water voyages. Public, model specific owner forums are limited, so much of the feedback comes from professional sea trials and survey documentation rather than a broad owner community.

On the water, professional reviews regularly praise the deep V hull for competent seakeeping and a composed, refined ride; sea trials have reported reaching published cruise and top speeds with no notable vibration. Pod-drive

configurations (IPS/Zeus) with joystick control simplify slow speed handling and docking, which is advantageous for owner operators. Interior reports emphasize quality joinery and upholstery, a roomy main deck and cockpit with ample sunpads, and a flybridge that provides a second helm plus sociable lounging space. The accommodation plan centers on an owner's cabin with guest cabins and a crew cabin with separate access; reviewers describe the master as compact yet comfortable with an ensuite shower.

Maintenance commentary in available records is favorable: a 2021 technical survey noted no significant issues, an engine room in good condition, and engines reported as almost new with under 100 hours at inspection, including two joysticks and standard propulsion/electrical checks marked satisfactory. Propulsion documented in listings and reviews includes Volvo D8 IPS 800 or Cummins QSC 8.3 paired to pod/IPS systems, indicating the usual dealer/service requirements for IPS/Zeus technology. No widespread recurring failures are recorded in expert reviews or the cited survey, though the small production numbers mean fewer publicly shared ownership experiences.

Pros and Cons

- Smooth, well refined ride with reliable seakeeping; typical cruise in the mid to high 20s knots and top speeds reported around 30–35 kn.
- Family oriented layout with a generous cockpit, sunpads, and a flybridge that includes a second helm and lounging area.
- Joystick equipped IPS/Zeus pod installations ease close quarters handling and docking.
- Limited market availability and fewer peer reviews due to boutique, low volume production.
- Designed primarily for coastal passages; its approximate 350 nm range is not intended for long blue water crossings.
- Pod drive systems generally require dealer support and scheduled service

for IPS/Zeus components.
