OVERVIEW

The 28 Center Console from VALENTINO is a multi-role motor yacht configured as a center console and built on a sturdy fiberglass and plastic hull. Offered by Andrey Shestakov and the international team at Shestakov Yacht Sales, this design prioritizes confident dayboating with reliable systems and easy upkeep.

Selecting a 28 Center Console

Picking the ideal center console becomes straightforward with professional advice. Andrey Shestakov and the Shestakov Yacht Sales team will match your priorities to the 28 Center Console's advantages: a compact 28 ft overall length, a 9 ft beam that enhances stability, and a single Suzuki outboard that keeps the mechanical layout simple. If you want a well-rounded motor yacht in the center console class, this model offers an equilibrium of usable deck space and a proven fiberglass and plastic hull.

Q: What type of yacht is the 28 Center Console? A: It's a **versatile** motor yacht arranged with a **practical** center console layout and constructed on a **robust** fiberglass and plastic hull.

Q: What are the key dimensions? A: The **LOA** measures 28 ft (8.53 m) and the **beam** is 9 ft (2.9 m), delivering a useful deck footprint and assured handling characteristics.

Q: What powers the boat? A: Propulsion is provided by a single **Suzuki outboard** using **gas**, chosen to keep systems simple and maintenance manageable.

Owner Experience Review

Owners of the 28 Center Console by VALENTINO report a ride that feels steady, secure, and notably dry, crediting the Carolina deep V hull design and pronounced bow flare. In everyday use these boats split time between family outings at sandbars and inshore to nearshore or light offshore fishing; many owners note the beamy 9'6" deck provides generous room for anglers and passengers alike. Listings and owner descriptions frequently point out an open forward area with bow seating, a leaning post cooler with built-in storage, an enclosed transom, and wrap around fishing access, plus cockpit seating for roughly six people. Well-equipped examples often include optional T tops or hard tops with several rod holders and aftermarket SeaDek for added comfort and finish.

Performance notes are detailed: one owner recorded WOT near 6100 rpm reaching about 48 mph, with an economical cruise around 4100 rpm at roughly 31 mph and about 3.4 mpg (results depend on prop choice). Owners typically address bow lift and cruise attitude with porta bracket adjustments and trim tab tuning, and forum threads concentrate on selecting the right prop pitch and hub to achieve proper WOT rpm. Maintenance feedback is pragmatic—some sellers stress strict 100 hour service intervals—while routine

outboard servicing and periodic inspections of the porta bracket are common practice. Individual outcomes vary by setup, but the prevailing view highlights a flexible, mixed use boat supported by uncomplicated systems.

Pros and Cons

- Stable, safe, and dry ride attributed to the Carolina deep V and bow flare.
- Flexible, beamy deck layout, enclosed transom, and wrap around fishing space that suit family days and mixed fishing/social use.
- Owner reported cruise near 31 mph at ~3.4 mpg suggests efficient operation when propped appropriately.
- Performance is prop sensitive, often necessitating experimentation with pitch and hub choices to optimize WOT and cruise.
- Porta bracket and trim tabs require setup and routine inspection, adding maintenance considerations.
- Best suited to inshore to nearshore and light offshore passages rather than prolonged bluewater transits.

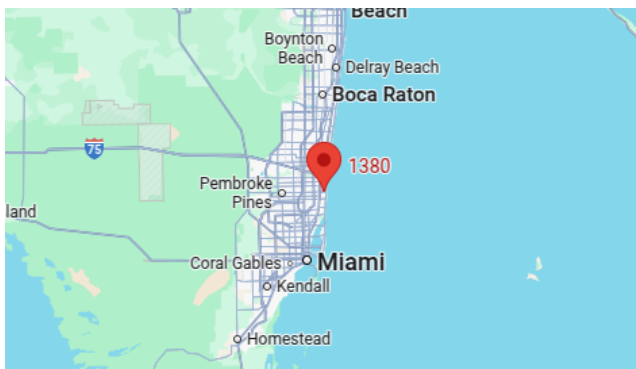
