The 43 Double Cabin from VIKING is a practical and comfortable motor yacht designed for easygoing coastal cruising and weekend getaways. Built with a sturdy fiberglass construction hull, powered by twin inboard diesel engines, and carrying sensible tankage, it appeals to owners who value straightforward systems and onboard comfort. Features of the Model

- Well-proportioned footprint: 43 ft (13.11 m) LOA with a 14 ft (4.5 m) beam that produces good handling characteristics and useful interior volume.
- Power and efficiency: twin inboard diesel setup (engine manufacturer listed as Unknown) providing reliable propulsion and relatively simple service requirements.
- Overnighting for two: accommodates 2 overnight guests—well suited to couples or a skipper plus guest on short cruises.
- Low-maintenance build: fiberglass construction hull paired with a fiberglass deck for durability and straightforward upkeep.

- Practical capacities: around 300 gal fuel and 100 gal water capacity to support extended day trips and short cruising legs.

Q1: What is the 43 Double Cabin in terms of category and build? A1: It is a

motor yacht marketed in the cruiser class and manufactured by VIKING. Notable specifications include **LOA 43 ft (13.11 m)** , **beam 14 ft (4.5 m)** , and a durable fiberglass construction hull with a **fiberglass** deck.

Q2: What powers the boat? A2: The yacht is driven by **twin inboard diesel** engines. The listed engine manufacturer is **Unknown** in available records; the setup is nonetheless chosen for straightforward servicing and dependable thrust.

Owner Experience Review

Owners typically employ the 43 Double Cabin by VIKING for coastal family cruising and relaxed weekend anchoring. The two-stateroom, galley-down configuration suits extended weekends, while the expansive aft deck and flybridge are frequently praised as comfortable, informal entertaining areas.

Underway, the modified-V hull is regarded as seaworthy and predictable rather than a high-performance hull. Reported cruise speeds are roughly 18–19 knots

with 310-hp GM 6-71s and about 22 knots with the larger 410-hp 6-71s, producing a steady, comfortable ride better suited to coastal passages than to modern high-speed runs.

Onboard accommodations include a notably roomy aft stateroom with several hanging lockers; both heads offer separate stall showers, and the dinette can convert to an additional double berth. Period notes indicate the salon is not particularly large. Maintenance on older boats can be hampered by limited factory spare parts and trim pieces—hatches and windshield components sometimes must be sourced from specialty vendors or custom-fabricated—and engine-room access is tight, though owners often adapt with quick hatch-removal routines. Many vessels have been repowered or upgraded electrically and mechanically, making this model a frequent candidate for refit projects or owners seeking longer-range capability.

Pros and Cons

- Seaworthy modified-V hull provides a comfortable, stable cruise for coastal passages.
- Two-stateroom, galley-down layout with a convertible dinette supports family cruising and weekend stays.
- Both heads have separate stall showers and the aft stateroom is notably large with multiple hanging lockers.
- The salon is not especially spacious compared to the generous aft stateroom.
- Factory spare and trim pieces for older boats can be scarce, often requiring custom fabrication or specialty suppliers.
- Engine-room access is tight for routine work, though owners report developing quick hatch-removal routines.
