OVERVIEW

Discover the performance-oriented 38 S from WAJER — a streamlined motor yacht in the cruiser segment built on a fiberglass construction hull with a fiberglass deck. Twin Volvo Penta inboard diesel engines produce a 28-knot cruise (32.22 mph) and reach up to 48 knots (55.24 mph).

Selecting a 38 S

The 38 S is ideal for buyers seeking a high-speed, low-fuss motor yacht that still offers the creature comforts of a compact cruiser. Measuring 38 ft (11.58 m) LOA with a 12 ft (3.76 m) beam, and equipped with a single head plus practical fuel and water reserves, it performs nimbly on day trips and short weekend cruises. Owner Experience Review

Owners and operators regard the 38 S by WAJER as a high-end dayboat and capable superyacht tender: it's commonly chosen for family outings, Riviera day charters, and chase-boat roles. Originally launched in 2015, the model has seen updates through 2020–2024 that introduced newer-generation options, including a later-installed foil-assist that reviewers and owners report reduces slamming and improves ride quality. The inclusion of a tow eye and plentiful storage makes watersports easy — you can stow Seabobs, wakeboards, and SUPs without encroaching on guest areas.

Independent sea trials note a composed, dry ride with predictable control in chop and during tight maneuvers. Normal cruising speeds are typically in the 25–30 knot range (most owners report about 28 knots), with top-end performance from the low 40s into the mid-40s or higher depending on engine selection and whether the boat is fitted with IPS or higher-output/outboard options. The center-console configuration maximizes social areas with a large foredeck sunpad and U-shaped aft seating, while the helm benefits from suspended Stidd chairs and an ergonomically arranged dashboard for comfortable long days. A compact head and fridge in the console, plus optional Seakeeper, air-conditioning, generator, and premium audio systems, make day trips genuinely comfortable, although sleeping accommodations are limited — realistically suitable for a single overnight or for two at most.

Maintenance is frequently cited as an advantage: one independent review described the model as “virtually maintenance free” due to modern construction and its tender/dayboat focus. WAJER supports owners through Wajer Care service hubs, and many pre-owned boats include a documented factory service history. Where fitted, Volvo Penta IPS pods offer excellent performance but necessitate specialist servicing compared with simpler outboard setups. The engine compartment is neatly organized with good access for service and still leaves significant room for toy storage, reinforcing the model’s practical tender heritage.

Pros and Cons

- Confident, dry ride with precise handling in chop and during tight turns.
- Well-considered dayboat layout featuring a large foredeck sunpad, U-shaped seating, center-console flow, and abundant toy stowage.
- Foil-assist option reduces slamming and improves ride, while add-ons like Seakeeper, A/C, and a generator boost day-use comfort.
- Limited overnight accommodation; best optimized for day use rather than extended cruising.
- Many examples use IPS pods that require specialist servicing and introduce more maintenance complexity than simple outboards.
- Real-world performance and top speed depend on engine choices and configurations, so expectations should be matched to the selected specification.

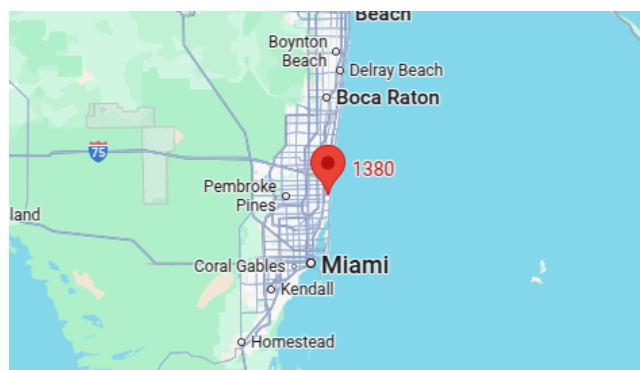
