The 222 Fisherman by WELLCRAFT is a 22-foot center console platform designed as a compact motor yacht with a robust fiberglass and plastic hull and a molded fiberglass deck. Driven by a single Yamaha gasoline outboard, it offers efficient cruising capability and straightforward handling tailored to both anglers and family day boaters.

Selecting a 222 Fisherman

If you're evaluating a capable 22 foot boat, the 222 Fisherman delivers a strong mix of dimensions and performance: 22 ft (6.71 m) LOA, an 8 ft (2.59 m) beam, and a Modified V Hull that promotes confident seakeeping. With a typical cruise around 30 knots (30 mph) and a top end near 40 knots (40 mph), it appeals to buyers looking for a practical center console arrangement within the motor yacht category built in fiberglass. - What type of yacht is the 222 Fisherman? It's a center console model within the motor yacht class, constructed to fiberglass and plastic standards.
- What are the dimensions of the boat? The **length overall** measures 22 ft

(6.71 m) and the **beam** is 8 ft (2.59 m).

- How fast does it go? The **cruising speed** is approximately 30 knots (30 mph), with a **maximum speed** near 40 knots (40 mph).
- What is the engine setup? Propulsion is provided by a **single Yamaha gas outboard**, chosen for its simplicity and reliable service network.

Owner Experience Review

Owners favor the 222 Fisherman from WELLCRAFT for offshore day fishing and bluewater runs, while it also performs well for family outings and coastal charter duties. Its deep V hull, with roughly 20° of deadrise, is frequently praised for delivering a comfortable ride in moderate chop and confidence in larger seas; one owner labeled it "one of the best riding 22' boats I've been on." With negative trim the bow tends to settle to soften chop, and the hull lifts cleanly when exiting troughs. Acceleration is brisk, and a reported test with a Yamaha F250 reached about 49 mph at 6,000 rpm.

Aboard, the arrangement strikes a balance between angling utility and family comfort. A forward console entry leads to an enclosed head compartment that accepts a porta potty, while the sizable cockpit, integrated bait/livewell, and overboard draining fishbox keep the working deck practical and tidy. Retractable bow seating, extensive storage, stainless fittings, and ergonomically minded layouts make it suitable for long days chasing sportfish or ferrying guests ashore.

Real world ownership feedback highlights a handful of maintenance items to monitor. Some owners have experienced rainwater or runoff entering the forward bilge/console, and there are isolated reports of water becoming

trapped between the deck and hull rather than draining to the bilge; proprietors and dealers have addressed these by adding or relocating bilge pumps and investigating faulty drains. Typical power is an outboard (Yamaha is common), so routine maintenance is straightforward, though several owners note that fuse labeling and console wiring sometimes need dealer or owner attention after delivery.

Pros and Cons

- Deep V hull with about 20° deadrise provides confident handling in moderate chop and offshore conditions.
- Strong hole shot and a tested top speed near 49 mph when equipped with a Yamaha F250.
- Functional deck and comfort features include a livewell, overboard draining fishbox, stowable bow seating, and an enclosed head.
- Some owners report rain or runoff entering the forward bilge/console.
- Isolated instances of water trapped between deck and hull that does not drain to the bilge.
- Fuse labeling and console wiring have required follow up by dealers or owners on some boats.
