OVERVIEW

Built by WELLCRAFT, the 222F is a flexible center console in the motor yacht category. Its hull features a Deep Vee form constructed from fiberglass and plastic with a fiberglass deck, and propulsion comes from a single Mercury outboard. Shestakov Yacht Sales, led by broker Andrey Shestakov, stands ready to assist with selection, purchase, and final delivery.

Selecting a 222F

The 222F suits buyers seeking a compact center console platform within the motor yacht range that emphasizes straightforward ownership and proven build methods. Measuring 22 ft (6.81 m) LOA with an 8 ft (2.59 m) beam, it strikes a balance between easy trailering and confident day-boat performance, while the Deep Vee hull contributes to reassuring handling in a variety of conditions.

- Hull and deck: Deep Vee geometry built on a fiberglass and plastic hull with a fiberglass deck
- Power and fuel: Single Mercury outboard; Gas/Petrol propulsion for familiar maintenance and service networks
- Capacities: 103 gal fuel; 9 gal freshwater to cover basic onboard needs
- Dimensions: LOA 22 ft (6.81 m); Beam 8 ft (2.59 m)
- Draft range: 4.374–8.475 ft (1.3333–2.5833 m)
- Category fit: A motor yacht built as a center console, intended for practical, open deck operation

- Q: What type of yacht is the 222F? A: It's a motor yacht configured as a center console, constructed on a fiberglass and plastic hull by WELLCRAFT. Notable dimensions include **LOA 22 ft** and **beam 8 ft**.
- Q: What engine and fuel does it use? A: The vessel is powered by a **single**

Mercury outboard running on **Gas/Petrol** , making maintenance and service straightforward with common dealer support.

• Q: What are the draft figures? A: Draft spans **4.374 ft (1.3333 m) min** to **8.475 ft (2.5833 m) max** , combined with a **Deep Vee** hull form that aids in confident entry and chop handling.

• Q: How much fuel and water can it carry? A: The 222F carries **103 gal fuel** and **9 gal water** , adequate for most day boating sorties.

Owner Experience Review

Owners typically employ the 222F in two main ways: as an inshore/nearshore fishing platform—thanks to a center console layout that emphasizes a large livewell and fishboxes—and as an easygoing family dayboat with stowable bow seats and optional Family/Bow Seating packages. At 22 feet the boat stays trailerable and is often paired with 150–250 hp outboards for a balanced fishing-and cruise capability.

On the water, users frequently report a stable, smooth ride. The 21° deep V hull helps keep things relatively dry and secure in choppy seas and is considered capable of handling offshore runs when conditions permit; with 150–200+ hp the boat feels quick and responsive, though cruising pace and acceleration are ultimately engine dependent.

The deck arrangement is laid out with anglers in mind—a bench helm with rod holders, a console mounted portable head, a 23 gallon aerated livewell, and a fishbox with an overboard drain—while upgraded bow seating options make non fishing days more comfortable. Owners do point out a few recurring quirks: the owner’s manual can be a generic document shared across

WELLCRAFT models, some factory fuse panels arrive unlabeled, and intermittent minor electrical or pump noises have been reported; regular small boat inspections and adherence to the recommended service intervals are commonly recommended.

Pros and Cons

- Stable deep V ride providing a relatively dry, secure feel in chop.
- Flexible layout that blends genuine fishing functionality with stowable bow seating for family use.
- A trailerable 22' hull that performs responsively when matched with 150–200+ hp outboards.
- Owner documentation is often generic across WELLCRAFT models, which can make specific details harder to find.
- Some boats are delivered with unlabeled fuse panels and minor electrical issues that usually require dealer attention.
- Occasional brief pump or bilge noises reported, despite systems continuing to function.
