Q: What type of yacht is the 290 Coastal? A: It is a motor yacht arranged in a walkaround layout with a fiberglass and plastic hull class, designed for confident deck access and solid structural integrity. The core **classification** details make it suitable for a range of coastal activities.

Q: What engines power the 290 Coastal? A: The model is equipped with 2 **Yamaha** engines in an **Outboard** setup running on **Gas** , providing responsive handling and uncomplicated maintenance routines.

## Owner Experience Review

---

Owners deploy the 290 Coastal by WELLCRAFT as a versatile platform—equally at home ferrying the family to nearby islands or heading offshore to chase tuna—while remaining easy enough for casual days on the water. Reports regularly highlight a composed ride and dependable stability in choppy conditions. Real-world numbers cited by owners include roughly 30 mph at 4000 RPM at about 1.3 mpg for one setup, and an efficient cruise near 34 mph at 4600 RPM at approximately 1.4 mpg for another; wide open throttle speeds commonly reach the mid to high 40s mph depending on equipment.

For those using it as a weekend cruiser, the cabin can sleep four using fold down berths and convertible settees, and many boats are outfitted with a full head featuring a macerator and separate shower, plus a galley area with a sink and refrigerator. Optional comforts such as AC/heat and full canvas or eisenglass enclosures are appreciated by owners who encounter colder or

windier conditions.

Maintenance conversations among owners focus on fishing systems and propulsion details. Common issues reported include slow baitwell circulation, frozen livewell valves, and occasional remote seacock actuator faults; some owners note the holding/gray water compartment beneath the cabin can swell if overfilled before returning to normal as levels drop. With numerous 290 Coastal examples running varied twin outboard packages across model years, prop selection and regular engine servicing are frequent topics, and individual performance depends on the specific engine configuration and condition.

## Pros and Cons

- Offshore capable cockpit with 42 gallon baitwell, in floor fish holds, and raw water washdown supports serious fishing.
- Weekend ready interior sleeps four, with a full head (macerator and separate shower) and a compact galley with sink and refrigerator.
- Smooth, stable ride in chop with owner reported cruise around 34 mph at ~1.4 mpg on twin 250s.
- Owners report livewell/seacock quirks, including frozen valves and remote actuator issues that require attention.
- Some boats show slow baitwell flow and need pump or plumbing troubleshooting to keep bait lively.
- Holding/gray water space can bulge if overfilled, and performance varies with engine setup and prop tuning.

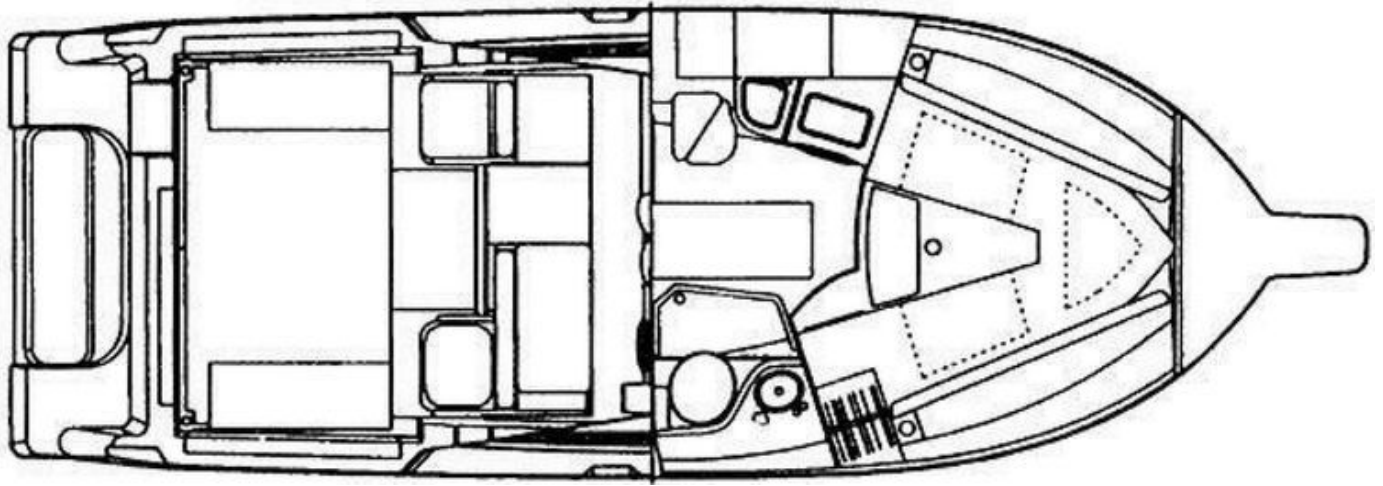
