OVERVIEW

The 32 Scarab Sport from WELLCRAFT is offered as a motor yacht featuring a center console arrangement built on a hull of fiberglass and plastic. This listing is presented by Shestakov Yacht Sales with brokerage services provided by Andrey Shestakov.

Selecting a 32 Scarab Sport

Deciding on the right vessel often hinges on intended use and preferred layout. The 32 Scarab Sport pairs the unobstructed sightlines and 360-degree deck access of a center console with the straightforward dependability of twin outboard power. For buyers seeking a practical, easy-to-operate motor yacht that balances capability and simplicity, this WELLCRAFT model delivers with proven systems and a robust fiberglass and plastic hull.

Features of the Model

- A spacious, uncluttered deck layout characteristic of a center console, enabling easy movement and safe handling underway.
- Twin Evinrude outboards (2 x Evinrude, Outboard) that prioritize simple operation and straightforward servicing.
- Overall Length 32 ft (9.75 m) with a 9 ft (3 m) beam, providing a well-proportioned footprint and usable deck area.
- Substantial onboard capacities for the class: fuel 281 gal and freshwater 8 gal.
- Sturdy construction: hull composed of fiberglass and plastic complemented by a fiberglass deck for durability and easier maintenance.
- Manufactured by WELLCRAFT, fitting squarely within the motor yacht category.

Questions and Answers

Q: What type of boat is the 32 Scarab Sport? A: It is a motor yacht built with a center console configuration by WELLCRAFT.

Q: What are the key dimensions of the 32 Scarab Sport? A: The **LOA** measures 32 ft (9.75 m) and the **beam** is 9 ft (3 m), offering a stable platform for the center console arrangement.

Q: What powers this model? A: Propulsion comes from **2** Evinrude **outboards** (2 x Evinrude, Outboard), chosen for reliability and ease of maintenance.

Q: What are the onboard capacities? A: **Fuel capacity** is 281 gal and **water capacity** is 8 gal, suitable for day outings and longer runs where fuel range is a priority.

Q: What materials are used in construction? A: The **hull** is built from fiberglass and plastic, with a fiberglass deck that contributes to longevity and straightforward care.

Owner Experience Review

Owners frequently buy the 32 Scarab Sport from WELLCRAFT to fulfill three principal roles: offshore sportfishing and tournament competition, serving as a tender or dayboat for larger yachts, and weekend family cruising with watersports mixed in. Typical cruise speeds reported fall in the 35–42 mph range, and the deep V stepped hull—approximately 24° at the transom—is often praised for delivering brisk acceleration, a notably dry and composed ride, and substantial top end performance. With twin 250–300 hp outboards, many owners report 45+ knots, while listings with higher horsepower installations have shown speeds in the 58–65 mph band. Owners who move up from a 25 footer commonly describe a marked improvement in ride quality and overall feel once on plane.

The walk in console offers standing headroom and includes a shower and sink, plus a lockable electronics area at the helm, making it possible to squeeze in occasional overnighting. The cockpit layout centers on a leaning post with built in cooler and extensive fish/storage solutions; anglers particularly appreciate the large livewell and several insulated fishboxes. Seating configurations vary by owner, and some customize the seating to carry 8–10 passengers for day trips. The compromise is a minimal dedicated galley—onboard arrangements favor bait prep and basic food preparation over a full cruising galley.

In routine ownership, towing a 32 ft boat can be inconvenient, so many owners opt to keep their Scarab in a slip rather than trailering frequently. Common maintenance notes include periodic seawater pump replacements and vigilance with in-floor storage drain channels. Repowers are not uncommon—examples include owners upgrading to Suzuki 300s—and twin outboard maintenance or eventual repower are recurring cost considerations. For older hulls, several owners have reported that WELLCRAFT tends to route parts and service requests through dealers, which can introduce extra steps when sourcing support.

Pros and Cons

- Deep V stepped hull provides rapid acceleration, a dry and steady ride, and impressive top speeds when paired with twin 250–300 hp engines.
- Excellent fishing capabilities with a large livewell, numerous insulated fishboxes, and a roomy cockpit optimized for anglers.
- Walk-in console with standing headroom, a shower, and a modest cuddy area supports occasional overnight stays for family outings.
- Trailering a 32 foot vessel can be cumbersome; as a result, many owners choose to keep the boat docked rather than haul it frequently.
- Limited dedicated galley space emphasizes bait and basic meal prep over full cruising galley amenities.
- Ongoing maintenance items such as seawater pump replacements and twin outboard servicing or repower expenses can contribute to ownership costs.
