OVERVIEW

The 352 Sport from WELLCRAFT is a multi-purpose motor yacht constructed with a resilient fiberglass and plastic hull and deck, propelled by triple Mercury outboards, and arranged with practical accommodations including a private head. Offered through Andrey Shestakov and the Shestakov Yacht Sales team, it's designed to combine straightforward functionality with the capability to enjoy confident days offshore.

Selecting a 352 Sport

Choosing the 352 Sport depends on how its core attributes align with your boating plans:

- You want a 35 ft (10.9 m) vessel with a 9 ft (3.02 m) beam that delivers stable handling and efficient deck layout.
- You prioritize the performance and dependability of triple Mercury outboard engines running on Gas/Petrol.
- You require practical onboard features: a private head, a substantial 400-gallon fuel reserve, and a tried-and-true fiberglass and plastic build complemented by a fiberglass deck.
- You appreciate working with an established brokerage—Andrey Shestakov at Shestakov Yacht Sales—to manage inspections, purchase logistics, and delivery coordination.

- Triple-engine confidence: 3 x Mercury outboards for balanced power delivery and redundancy.

Questions and Answers

Q: What type of yacht is the 352 Sport? A: It is a motor yacht built with a resilient fiberglass and plastic construction, intended for versatile, confident use on the water.

Q: What engines power the boat? A: Three Mercury outboards running on **Gas/Petrol** , providing the responsiveness and redundancy many operators prefer.

Q: What are the key dimensions? A: **LOA 35 ft (10.9 m)** and **beam 9 ft (3.02 m)** , proportioned for stable performance and practical deck usage.

Q: What is the draft range? A: The **draft** ranges from a minimum of 6.288 ft (1.9166 m) to a maximum of 9.022 ft (2.75 m), allowing operation in varied depths.

Q: How much fuel and water does it carry? A: **Fuel capacity** is 400 gal and **fresh water** capacity is 13 gal, and the boat includes 1 head for onboard convenience. For purchasing advice, contact Andrey Shestakov at Shestakov Yacht Sales.

Owner Experience Review

Owners and evaluators report the 352 Sport from WELLCRAFT as delivering a smooth ride, quick responsiveness, and manageable handling in confined spaces. The deep V hull (roughly 23 degrees at the transom) offers clean tracking offshore, while the triple outboards supply confident handling, brisk acceleration, and high top-end performance. Instrumented runs with triple 400R Verados recorded approximately 57 mph at 6,800 rpm, with the most fuel-efficient cruise near 31.1 mph around 4,000 rpm; as is common with high-performance center consoles, fuel consumption increases rapidly at

wide-open throttle.

In routine use, the center-console arrangement works well for offshore sportfishing, with options for a tower or second station, and bow seating plus a forward console seat to keep non-anglers comfortable. A forward berth and a flushing marine head make short overnights for two feasible, and the adaptable deck layout transitions easily between fishing and entertaining in calm to moderate seas. Many owners also note a large, roughly 376-gallon fuel capacity that supports longer passages and some crossing-capable itineraries.

Practical observations include a console door that can block the passageway when opened. On the maintenance side, three outboards mean higher routine service and fuel expenses compared to single- or twin-engine setups. Community feedback on older Wellcrafts highlights occasional wiring and electrical attention, bilge and fishbox drainage troubleshooting, and routine upholstery care; owners consistently emphasize diligent saltwater engine maintenance—regular flushing and proper winterization—to help prevent corrosion-related issues.

Pros and Cons

- Smooth, responsive handling with strong offshore seakeeping from the deep V ($\approx 23^\circ$) hull.
- Flexible layout that balances offshore sportfishing capability with family friendly bow seating and a small cabin/head suitable for two.
- Triple outboard configuration provides assured acceleration and high performance, with an efficient cruise range near 31 mph.
- Triple outboards result in higher maintenance and operating costs versus single or twin setups.
- Fuel consumption escalates rapidly at wide open throttle despite notable top speed.

- The console door may obstruct the walkway when opened.
