OVERVIEW

The 605 from WENDON MANUFACTURING is a sophisticated motor yacht platform realized as a bona fide power catamaran built with fiberglass construction expertise. Presented by Shestakov Yacht Sales with broker Andrey Shestakov, the design pairs the inherent stability and volume of twin hulls with practical range and onboard comforts ideal for confident coastal cruising.

Selecting a 605

Opting for the 605 is a logical choice if you want a 75 ft (22.86 m) yacht that leverages the spaciousness of a catamaran while retaining the straightforwardness of inboard diesel propulsion. With a 22 ft (6.71 m) beam and five heads, the layout accommodates guests comfortably, and its 10 knot cruising speed with a 20 knot top end gives you operational flexibility when planning passages. As listed by Andrey Shestakov of Shestakov Yacht Sales, the 605 suits owners who value a balanced mix of roominess and performance.

Features of the Model

- Twin hull architecture: a stable power catamaran foundation that delivers generous beam and comfortable behavior both underway and at anchor.
- Construction: robust fiberglass build for the hulls and a fiberglass deck designed for straightforward maintenance.
- Performance envelope: economical 10 knot cruising with the ability to reach 20 knots for faster transits or schedule adjustments.
- Propulsion: paired inboard Caterpillar diesel engines providing reliable propulsion and service support.
- Category fit: positioned in the premium motor yacht class while offering the practical benefits inherent to a twin hull arrangement.

Questions and Answers

Q1: What type of yacht is the 605? A1: It is a motor yacht design executed as a true power catamaran featuring a fiberglass construction hull, offering stability, internal volume, and fuel efficient performance.

Q2: What are the key dimensions of the model? A2: The 605 measures **75 ft**

LOA (22.86 m) with a **22 ft beam** (6.71 m) and a **14.764 ft draft** (4.5 m), delivering substantial interior space and twin hull steadiness.

Q3: What propulsion and speeds does it offer? A3: Driven by **two Caterpillar inboard diesel** engines, the yacht cruises at **10 knots** (11.51 mph) and can reach a **20 knot** (23.02 mph) maximum speed.

Q4: What onboard capacities and amenities stand out? A4: The vessel includes **5 heads**, a **700 gallon fuel capacity** and a **350 gallon water capacity** which together support extended time between port calls.

Owner Experience Review

Based on the brokerage descriptions and sales materials, the 605 from WENDON MANUFACTURING is marketed as a long range pilothouse motoryacht/power cat suitable for family cruising. The documented interior plan typically features four staterooms and five heads, a main salon with a complete galley, a pilothouse with expansive glazing, and a flybridge helm.

Photographic listings highlight ample interior volume and several social zones — including the salon, flybridge, and aft deck — and some examples are fitted out for full liveaboard capability with conveniences such as a washer/dryer. Advertised on water characteristics attribute a smooth, stable ride and solid seakeeping to the catamaran hull, with published operating speeds around a 10 knot cruise and roughly 20 knots max. During this review, no independent sea trial documentation or owner firsthand handling reports specific to the model were located, nor were there active, model focused forum discussions

uncovered. Mechanically, multiple listings reference twin Caterpillar C12 diesel installations, and no recurring, model specific mechanical failures were identified in public sources. As customary in brokerage listings, careful survey and inspection are recommended, and no public owner maintenance logs were found. The model is promoted for private use or charter, though independent charter operator evaluations were not available.

Pros and Cons

- Listings credit the catamaran hull with delivering a smooth, stable ride and commendable seakeeping characteristics.
- Generous 4 stateroom/5 head arrangement with a salon, full galley, pilothouse, and flybridge, plus liveaboard features such as washer/dryer shown on some boats.
- Brokerage materials promote flexibility for private cruising or charter deployment.
- No independent sea trial reports, owner firsthand handling accounts, or active owner forum threads were identified in public records.
- Claims of charter suitability are based on listings; no third party charter operator reviews were located.
- No publicly available owner maintenance logs; prospective buyers must depend on survey and inspection to verify condition.

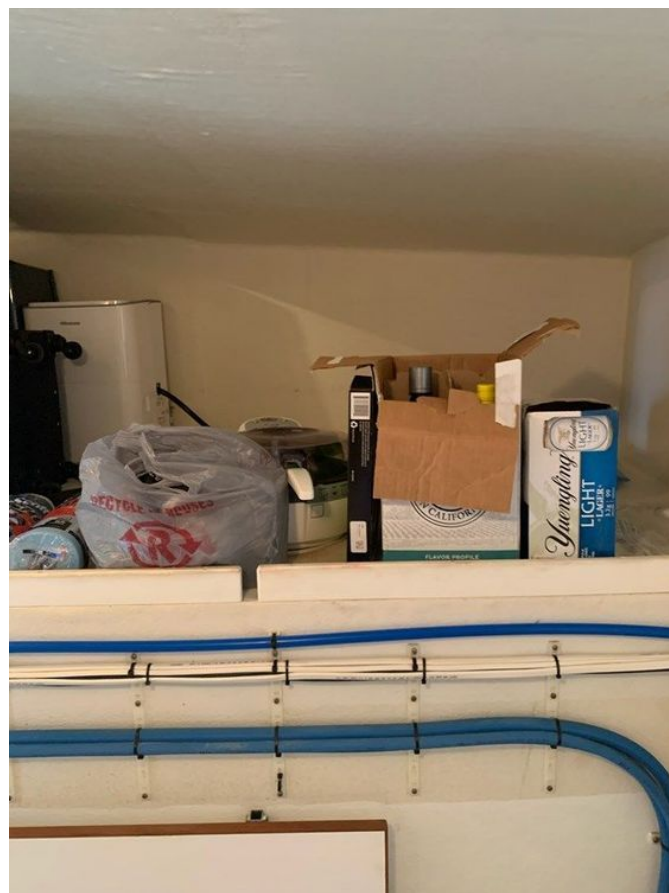

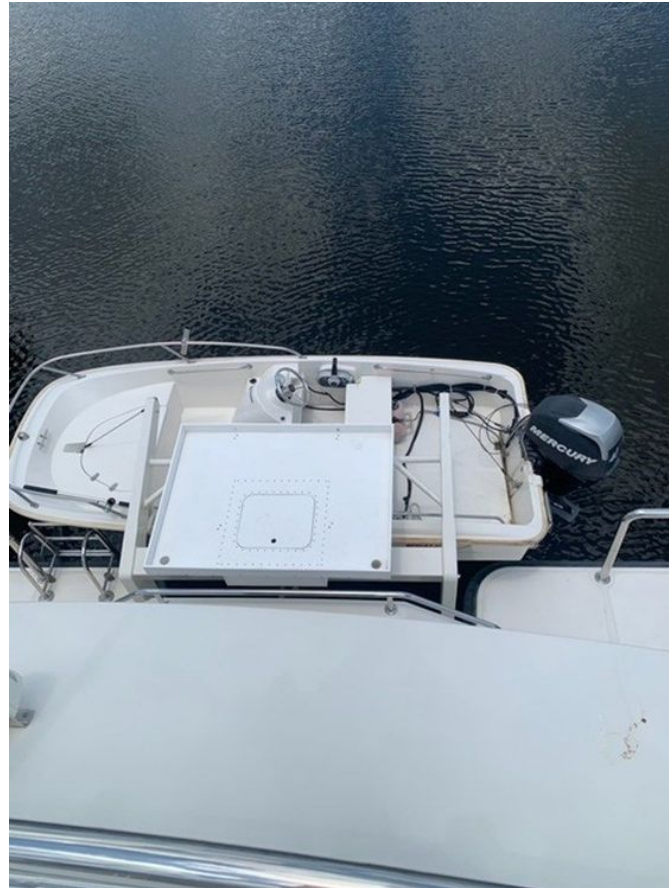
