Crafted by WESTCOASTER, the 70 Flybridge Cruiser is a purpose-built motor yacht that doubles as a serious sport fisherman and a comfortable coastal cruiser, built on a durable fiberglass hull. With twin Volvo Penta inboard diesels driving a Westcoaster-designed planing hull, it delivers an efficient 10-knot cruise and a confident 17-knot top end. Shestakov Yacht Sales, led by broker Andrey Shestakov, stands ready to support you from selection through delivery.

Selecting the 70 Flybridge Cruiser is about matching a multifunctional platform to your boating program: it combines the sea-keeping and deck space of a motor yacht with the fishing-focused layout of a sport fisherman. The 17 ft (5.41 m) beam and a fiberglass hull with planing lines deliver dependable ride quality, while twin Volvo Penta inboard diesels provide the range and performance needed for offshore passages. With three heads and substantial tankage, the design supports extended stays aboard. Contact Andrey Shestakov and the Shestakov Yacht Sales team to align this hull and layout with your intended use.

Questions and Answers

Q: What type of yacht is the 70 Flybridge Cruiser? A: It's a flexible motor yacht with the design intent and features of a sport fisherman, set on a resilient fiberglass hull with a planing hull form.

Q: What engines power it, and what fuel does it use? A: The boat is fitted with 2 x Volvo Penta **inboard** engines running on **diesel** , providing dependable offshore capability and straightforward servicing.

Q: How fast does it go? A: Plan on a **cruise speed** of 10 knots (about 11.51 mph) and a **maximum speed** of 17 knots (about 19.56 mph), figures that align with the planing hull characteristics.

Q: What are the key dimensions and capacities? A: LOA measures **70 ft (21.34 m)** , beam is **17 ft (5.41 m)** , and draft is **8.475 ft (2.5833 m)** . Fuel capacity is **1,585.03 gal** , with fresh water at **317.01 gal** .

Owner Experience Review

Owners operating the 70 Flybridge Cruiser from WESTCOASTER report it as a purpose-designed platform for long-range bluewater sportfishing, backed by roughly 6,000 L of fuel for extended offshore legs. Its sturdy GRP construction and predictable handling in Far North Queensland and PNG conditions give owners confidence when heading offshore. Everyday life aboard is

uncomplicated: four cabins and three heads accommodate eight guests, including a full-beam master with ensuite; the saloon and galley are arranged for comfortable living, and the flybridge/wheelhouse delivers clear sightlines for navigation and fishing.

Range and fuel economy depend heavily on loadout and configuration. A comparable Westcoaster charter boat is cited as capable of about 200 nm at an approximate 10-knot cruising pace as an operational example, but actual results will differ by vessel. Published cruise and top-speed figures vary between sources—some list 10/17 kn while other detailed notes suggest about 17 kn cruise and near 21 kn top—so owners should verify propulsion components and propeller choices during survey and sea trials.

Maintenance commentary focuses on accessible systems and conventional equipment. Listings highlight a thoughtfully arranged engine room and twin Volvo Penta TAMD diesels with options for Veem props; routine inboard maintenance and attention to propeller and shaft gear are typical. Recent sale notices reference antifouling and diver cleaning, and a broker observed over 250k spent on maintenance between 2023–2025 on the example vessel; prospective buyers should examine invoices closely and commission a full independent survey.

Pros and Cons

- Robust GRP construction with confident seakeeping in demanding Far North Queensland/PNG operating conditions.
- Extended range potential from roughly 6,000 L of fuel, tailored to bluewater sportfishing missions.
- Flexible accommodation: four cabins and three heads, roomy saloon/galley, and a large teak aft deck that converts between fishing layout and entertaining space.

- Reported cruise and top-speed numbers are inconsistent across sources and require confirmation through survey and sea trial.
- Published range and economy examples derive from a similar Westcoaster charter vessel and may not reflect every owner's configuration.
- Broker-noted accessibility to the engine room and recent maintenance expenditures should be verified with supporting invoices and an independent survey.
