OVERVIEW

Presented by Shestakov Yacht Sales with broker Andrey Shestakov, the EXPRESS from WINTER CUSTOM YACHTS is a bespoke 65 foot performance motor yacht crafted as a thoroughbred sport fisherman. It rides on a planing running surface and features a robust fiberglass and plastic hull. Twin MAN inboard diesel engines provide the power to sustain a 30 knot cruise and reach a 40 knot top end, making for confident runs to the fishing grounds.

Selecting a EXPRESS

Opting for the EXPRESS is a logical choice when you want a purpose-built sport fisherman that also performs as a fast, capable motor yacht for extended coastal hops. With a planing hullform, potent MAN diesel propulsion, and build practices consistent with fiberglass and plastic construction, it strikes a balance between speed, durability, and angling utility.

Features of the Model

- Built by WINTER CUSTOM YACHTS with the same team responsible for both hull and interior design, ensuring a unified execution.
- A performance oriented planing hull tuned to deliver a 30 knot cruise and a 40 knot top speed.
- LOA of 65 ft (19.81 m) and a beam of 18 ft (5.74 m) provide a steady, roomy fishing platform.
- Twin MAN inboard diesel engines provide dependable, efficient propulsion.
- Construction follows fiberglass and plastic principles with a fiberglass deck for long term durability.
- Generous tankage including 1,875 gallons of fuel and 250 gallons of freshwater supports extended offshore days.

Q: What type of yacht is the EXPRESS? A: It is a **motor yacht** engineered as a high performance **sport fisherman** constructed with a **fiberglass and plastic hull**.

Q: What are the performance numbers? A: The yacht's **cruise speed** is 30 knots (34.52 mph) and its **top speed** is 40 knots (46.03 mph).

Q: What powers the yacht? A: Propulsion comes from **2 x MAN inboard diesel** engines.

Q: Who handled the design? A: Both the **hull** and **interior** layouts were created by WINTER CUSTOM YACHTS.

Owner Experience Review

Owners who split time between family cruising, island runs in the Bahamas, and tournament fishing tend to favor the EXPRESS from WINTER CUSTOM YACHTS. The design is well suited to owner operators—many are run by an owner and spouse without a professional crew—yet it retains the speed and purposeful layout expected from a serious sportfishing platform.

On the water, owners and sea trials report offshore capability with Carolina style seakeeping that remains composed in head seas and conveys a big boat demeanor. Performance is notably brisk for an express; a 53 foot example has been recorded cruising in the high 30s to low 40s knot range. These yachts plane quickly and offer responsive handling useful for both sportfishing and fast coastal passages.

Inside, larger 50–65 foot hulls present interiors with yachtlike appointments—full size master staterooms, step down showers, and saloon/galley arrangements configured to the owner's brief—while cockpit and mezzanine areas are planned for entertaining as well as tournament work. Fit and finish and ergonomic detailing are highly personalized, and

serviceability receives praise: engine room access is typically good, electrical distribution is tidy, Racor filters are reachable, and generators are accessible; many owners equip their builds with watermakers and ice chippers.

Construction is described as cold molded plywood with fir stringers and a composite upper structure, so routine inspection of wood core areas is recommended; because each EXPRESS is a custom build, individual features and arrangements vary and each hull should be assessed on its own merits.

Pros and Cons

- Offshore capable Carolina style seakeeping that instills confidence in head seas.
- Brisk express performance with rapid planing and responsive handling suitable for fishing and fast cruising.
- Custom, yachtlike interiors and spacious cockpit/mezzanine layouts that accommodate both entertaining and tournament requirements.
- Cold molded construction means wood core areas require ongoing monitoring as part of routine maintenance.
- Highly customized layouts and finishes vary by hull, so buyers should verify a specific arrangement meets their needs.
- Some amenities found on larger 50–65 foot hulls may be absent from smaller builds, so expectations should be aligned to vessel size.
