## Owner Experience Review

---

Owners operating the 290 DC from WORLD CAT commonly praise its dual-purpose nature for both angling and family days. Anglers highlight the 30-gallon livewell, an array of rod holders, generous fish boxes, dedicated tackle storage and a large forward storage box as central to its fishing functionality. For family use, the dual-console design, bow loungers, wraparound cushion seating and a removable round table make the cockpit adaptable for socializing, while the enclosed head with sink and pump-out supports extended coastal overnighting. On the water, the Vectorflo air-cushion hull is credited with delivering a cushioned ride through chop and significantly reducing forward spray; reviewers report that spray is largely mitigated. Published performance figures show about 28 mph at roughly 3,500 rpm returning near 1.82 mpg, with a top speed in the neighborhood of 46.5 mph when equipped with twin 250s. The helm layout earns consistent praise for ergonomics, space for a large MFD and overall ease of handling. Reported compromises include a tendency to roll in a trough and some pounding when idling into a head sea, and owners frequently discuss propeller choices and tuning to optimize real-world speed and economy. Maintenance attention centers on standard twin-outboard schedules; owner forums and the manufacturer's manual emphasize routine service intervals and setup rather than recurring structural concerns.

## Pros and Cons

- Smooth, cushioned ride in chop with Vectorflo hull and reduced forward spray.
- Fish-and-family versatility with 30-gal livewell, ample rod holders, big fish boxes, and convertible social seating.
- Ergonomic helm with space for a large MFD and abundant storage, making it easy to skipper and organize gear.
- Can roll in a trough and may pound when idling up-sea in certain conditions.
- Real-world speed and efficiency depend on prop selection and setup, often requiring owner experimentation.
- Twin outboards demand routine service attention, even if no widespread structural issues are reported.
