# OVERVIEW

---

2600 TRS by YAMAHA delivers a capable center console yacht experience within the broader world of motor yachts. Presented by Shestakov Yacht Sales and broker Andrey Shestakov, this 26-foot platform balances simplicity and utility for confident days on the water.

## Selecting a 2600 TRS

---

If you need a compact vessel that still performs, the 2600 TRS is a strong contender. Its overall length of 26 ft (7.92 m) combined with an 8 ft (2.64 m) beam provides the easy maneuverability and unobstructed deck circulation expected from a center console yacht. The single outboard arrangement simplifies ownership and slots neatly into the motor yachts category.

## Features of the Model

---

- A single Yamaha outboard powers the boat, keeping propulsion straightforward and economical.
- At 26 ft LOA with an 8 ft beam, the design finds equilibrium between nimble handling and usable deck area.
- A 70 gallon fuel tank provides the range needed for full day excursions.
- The center-console format prioritizes open deck utility and direct, unobstructed helm access as a center console yacht.

## Owner Experience Review

---

Owners frequently describe the 2600 TRS as a true multi role boat: comfortable for family outings with generous forward seating, while the TRS

third row converts for picnic seating and carries several passengers easily. It also performs well as a bay boat for inshore and light offshore fishing—suitable for light tackle, jigging, and even guide style charters. Many owners trailer it with half ton pickups for extended coastal runs and enjoy bringing it ashore for beach days and snorkel stops.

On the water one owner summarized: “A great rough riding boat... 2 to 4 foot, no problem at 30mph. Super dry and no pounding.” Test runs praise the High Performance Step hull for quick responsiveness and nimble handling. With a YAMAHA F300, measured cruise efficiency is about 30 knots at 4,000 rpm (~11.8 gph), two way average top runs near 44.9 knots, and owners have reported top speeds above 50 mph.

Comfort-minded features cater to families: the TRS stern lids flip up into padded seating for four, while the foredeck converts into a lounge using hinged fish box backs. There are tradeoffs; users note the console entry is snug for larger adult males and interior headroom is approximately 5 feet. Maintenance demands are higher than on simpler boats because of added systems (livewells, jackplate, trim tabs, bow mount motor, head, numerous hatches), and many owners modify battery layouts to accommodate a leaning post cooler or expanded house power. On the plus side, YAMAHA outboards (F300/F350 options) are regarded as dependable when serviced to manufacturer recommendations, and prop selection—usually fine tuned with dealer help—often makes the difference in achieving target top speeds. As one owner reflected after 18 months and close to 200 hours: “All I can say is that we love it!”

## Pros and Cons

---

- Versatile layout that suits both family cruising and fishing, featuring a forward lounge and TRS third row seating for four.

- Owners report a dry, non-pounding ride in 2–4 ft chop at 30 mph and responsive handling courtesy of the stepped hull design.
- Independent testing indicates an efficient cruise near 30 knots (~11.8 gph) with two-way top runs around 44.9 knots and reported top speeds over 50 mph.
- The console entry feels tight for adult males and interior headroom is limited to about 5 feet.
- Servicing needs are greater than simpler hulls due to many onboard systems and the associated plumbing and wiring.
- Reaching the preferred top speed commonly requires experimenting with propeller choices in consultation with a dealer.
