Q: What type of boat is the FSH 255 SPORT E? A: It is a motor yacht constructed with a fiberglass and plastic hull and manufactured by YAMAHA.

Q: What are the dimensions of the model? A: The **LOA** measures 24 ft (7.47 m).

Q: How is the yacht powered? A: Propulsion is provided by a **single engine** from YAMAHA.

Q: What is the fuel capacity? A: The stated **fuel capacity** for this model is 50 gallons.

Owner Experience Review

Owners of the FSH 255 SPORT E built by YAMAHA report that the boat suits larger-family outings while retaining focus on bay and near shore fishing. They highlight the seating versatility — bow seats that fold flat into a sunpad, a double leaning post for helm comfort, and full beam aft seating with a stowable bench — which simplifies day trips and tow sports, aided by the integrated tow pylon. Anglers appreciate the open casting decks, two cockpit livewells (one forward transparent well and an aft 30 gallon well), and onboard capacity to stow roughly 25 rods. Owners also note a 111 gallon fuel tank supports extended cruises, with real world testing indicating approximately 200+ miles of fishing range.

On the water the boat is reported to get on plane rapidly with modest bow rise and to feel sporty with strong acceleration from twin supercharged SVHO engines. Its shallow draft and the YAMAHA articulating keel contribute to straight tracking and make the boat practical for flats and bay work. There are tradeoffs: owners call attention to engine and supercharger noise, prompting many to install sound damping in the engine compartment, and some have added a trolling motor to improve low speed positioning. Early ownership experiences have included warranty visits for issues such as an electrical/transom short on a new boat, reverse bucket actuator failures that stuck closed, cosmetic and manufacturing adjustments, and a need to relocate the fire extinguisher because of the engine bay fire port arrangement. When these expectations are understood, buyers still cite the model's versatility and performance as the primary reasons for choosing it.

Pros and Cons

- Flexible seating arrangements and a tow pylon make family outings and watersports convenient.

- Fishing amenities are comprehensive: two livewells, open casting space, and storage for about 25 rods.
- Gets on plane quickly, offers strong SVHO acceleration (as reported), and benefits from shallow draft tracking via the articulating keel.
- Engine and supercharger noise are commonly noted; many owners add acoustic insulation in the engine bay.
- Reports of steering oddities and reverse bucket actuator failures have required dealer attention.
- Early electrical and cosmetic/manufacturing issues have led to warranty service visits, and the engine bay fire port layout has necessitated relocating the fire extinguisher.

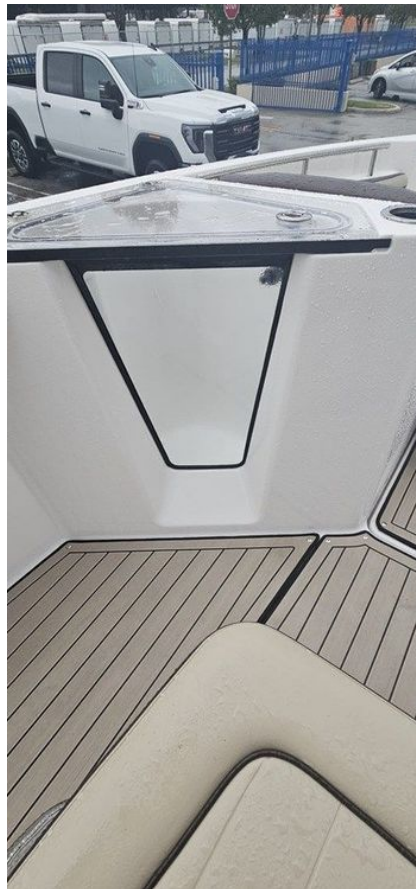
