The 27 Center Console from YAMANE marries straightforward design with capable performance in a compact motor yacht crafted for the sport fisherman. Constructed with fiberglass and plastic components, driven by twin outboards, and centered on an uncomplicated helm, it's presented as a reliable option for anglers and day boaters represented by Shestakov Yacht Sales.

Selecting a 27 Center Console

If your priority is a nimble center console that emphasizes fishing practicality and simple maintenance, the 27 Center Console should be on your consideration list. With a factory-stated cruise speed of 32 kn (36.83 mph), a top end near 48 kn (55.24 mph), twin Suzuki outboards, and an 8 ft beam, it suits buyers searching for an agile motor yacht positioned in the sport fisherman category. Q: What type of boat is the 27 Center Console? A: It's a compact motor yacht set up for the sport fisherman market, constructed on a durable fiberglass and plastic foundation.

Q: What engines power this model and how fast is it? A: Twin **Suzuki**

outboards provide propulsion, with a listed cruising speed of **32 kn** (36.83 mph) and a top speed near **48 kn** (55.24 mph).

Q: What are the key dimensions and capacities? A: LOA **27 ft** (8.23 m), beam **8 ft** (2.44 m), max draft **6.562 ft** (2 m), fuel capacity **90 gal** , and **1 head** .

Q: Who builds it and who represents it for purchase? A: The builder is YAMANE and it's listed through Shestakov Yacht Sales; contact **Andrey Shestakov** for availability and next steps.

Q: What hull and deck materials are specified? A: The hull is categorized as fiberglass and plastic and the deck is **Fiberglass** , matching its sport fisherman intent.

Owner Experience Review

Drawing from manufacturer literature and brokerage postings, the 27 Center Console by YAMANE is presented as a T-top center-console built for fishing, day cruising, and adaptable utility tasks. Descriptions of the 2024 model emphasize an open day-boat configuration without enclosed sleeping spaces, seating capacity in the 6–8 range, and a beam near 2.67 m, positioning the boat for short coastal or inshore adventures rather than extended overnight use.

On-water performance expectations are based on listing data rather than extensive owner ride narratives: brokers reference a cruise near 32 knots and a peak around 48 knots, and the builder calls out a shallow draft with a hull shape intended to slice through waves with stability. These claims are consistent across sales materials but should be validated through a sea trial for personal confirmation.

Maintenance and ownership outlook depend heavily on the chosen outboard package and optional equipment; listings reference warranty coverage typically

in the 1–3 year range, but there is limited publicly available long-term owner feedback or repeatability in issue reporting at this stage.

Pros and Cons

- Versatile mission: marketed for fishing, day cruising, and configurable work or utility duties according to manufacturer and broker notes.
- Performance claims: broker materials suggest a brisk day-boat pace with roughly a 32-knot cruise and a 48-knot top speed.
- Day-boat layout: T-top center-console, passenger capacity around 6–8, and a shallow draft make it well suited for coastal and inshore operations.
- Limited accommodation: absence of enclosed cabins and a focus on day use restrict options for overnighting and full weather protection.
- Unverified ride data: performance and ride comfort are primarily manufacturer/broker claims with little independent owner ride-test confirmation.
- Unclear long-term reliability: warranty terms vary from 1–3 years, and maintenance demands depend on the selected outboards, with limited long-term owner data available.
