OVERVIEW

The 34 Offshore by YELLOWFIN is a center-console motor yacht built on a fiberglass construction foundation. Propulsion comes from three Mercury outboard motors (Gas/Petrol), enabling a cruising pace around 40 kn (40 mph) and a top capability near 70 kn (70 mph). With a 419-gallon fuel tank and a single practical head, this model balances range and simplicity. When your priorities include brisk performance, uncomplicated handling, and the unrestricted deck layout of a center console, the 34 Offshore stands out. Measuring 34 ft overall with a 10 ft beam, it offers a stable platform while its trio of Mercury outboards delivers swift transfers between fishing grounds or coastal stops. - Performance-focused drivetrain: triple Mercury outboard engines (Gas/Petrol) designed for quick acceleration and efficient cruising.
- Verified speeds: a typical cruise near 40 kn (40 mph) with a maximum capability up to 70 kn (70 mph).
- Functional layout: true center console design that includes an easily accessed single head.
- Durable build: fiberglass hull paired with a fiberglass deck for long-term dependability.

center console configuration with a fiberglass hull.

- What is the **speed** profile? Typical cruise is around 40 kn (40 mph) and the top recorded speed reaches up to 70 kn (70 mph).
- What are the key **dimensions** and onboard amenities? LOA is 34 ft (10.36 m), beam 10 ft (3.05 m), max draft 5.741 ft (1.75 m), and the boat includes 1 head.

Owner Experience Review

Owners who routinely take this model offshore describe the 34 Offshore from YELLOWFIN as a center-console that prioritizes sportfishing but also delivers composed handling. Independent reviewers frequently praise its dry ride in choppy conditions and note that it "tracks like it's on rails," attributes often credited to the hull geometry and a broad chine for lateral stability. One owner summed up performance for Pacific conditions, noting comfortable cruising in the 40s and reachable top speeds in the 50s, so running at the 70 knot extreme is unnecessary for many.

Fishability and day-boat versatility are both evident aboard. The step-down console contains a roomy head compartment and offers straightforward access to wiring and electronics. Capacity is notable, with 50–55 gallon livewells, multiple in-deck fish boxes, and forward/coffin storage options. For family outings, the optional forward wraparound seating with powered backrests and a filler cushion converts into a sunpad, adding flexible seating and lounging space for day trips or short cruises.

Practical ownership observations mirror common listing notes and forum discussions. Some owners highlight trailer use and island-hopping capability,

while maintenance items are concentrated in a large cockpit lazarette that stores pumps and fuel filters. Older boats frequently show lifecycle upgrades—new engines, updated electronics, or replacement fuel tanks—so prospective buyers should budget for periodic refits. There are also owner-reported challenges contacting YELLOWFIN customer support, a reminder that after-sales experiences can differ.

Pros and Cons

- Dry, settled ride in chop with confident, on rails tracking.
- Serious fish and storage capacity plus optional forward sunpad seating for family use.
- Step down console with a dedicated head and a spacious cockpit lazarette for centralized service access.
- Older examples commonly show lifecycle refits (engines, electronics, fuel tanks) that increase ownership costs and downtime.
- Some owners report difficulty reaching YELLOWFIN customer support.
- Family-comfort items such as forward wraparound seating are optional and may not be fitted on every 34 Offshore.
